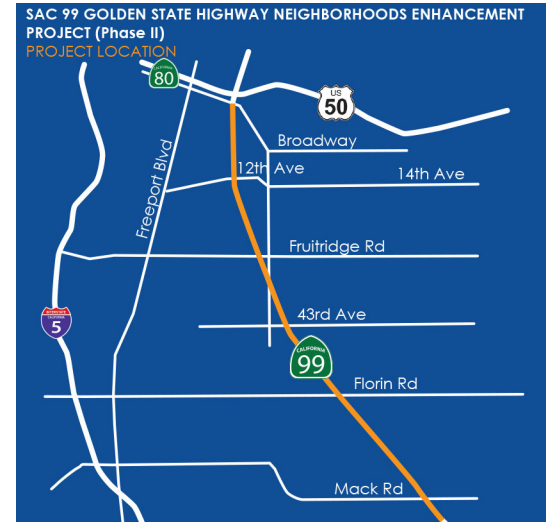

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The SAC-99 (Phase II) Beautification project will improve and upgrade a 9-mile stretch of State Route 99 between the Broadway Undercrossing and the Stockton Boulevard Overcrossing in the City of Sacramento in Sacramento County. SR99 is a main thoroughfare with South Sacramento residents and provides critical north and south connections to Downtown Sacramento and Elk Grove. SR99 also serves as a vital interregional connection for residents, visitors, and freight to travel throughout the region. The project has underserved communities within the project boundaries and Caltrans will facilitate community outreach to these underserved communities. Caltrans is working closely with the City of Sacramento to coordinate and engage the local Community Based Organizations to collaborate on the design concept.

- Improved lighting will make pedestrian and cyclists safer as they cross our facilities on approved over and undercrossing
- Install steel art panels on painted sound walls at 6 locations
- Aesthetic fencing upgrade will be added at 13 bridges and pedestrian crossings along the route - the fencing will improve the appearance of the facility, enhance the experience residents have when crossing the facility, and improve the appearance of the facility to highway users
- Caltrans will sponsor the installation of two murals, visible to the residents of the neighborhoods through which the highway runs at 2nd Avenue and 21st Avenue
