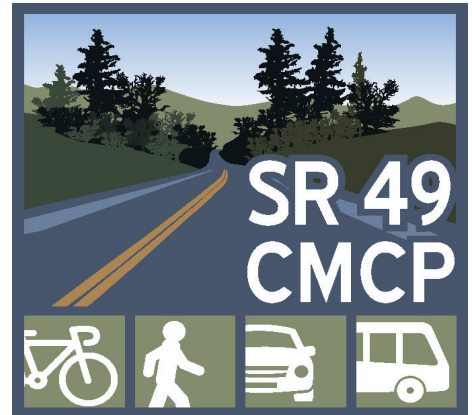
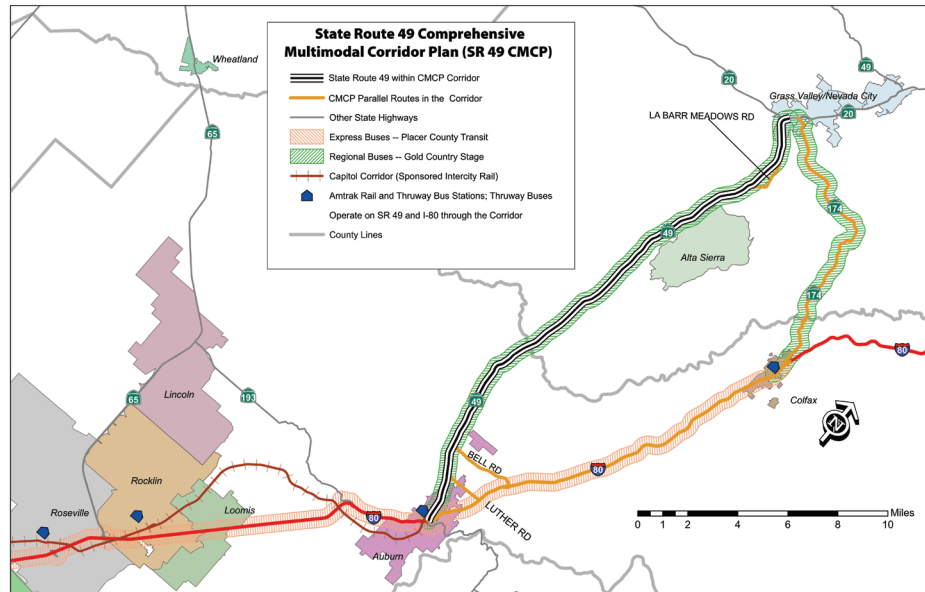


State Route 49 Comprehensive Multimodal Corridor Plan

The State Route 49 Comprehensive Multimodal Corridor Plan (SR 49 CMCP) will help Caltrans and our partners establish a unified vision for the corridor as one complete transportation system connecting communities, jobs, services and healthy lifestyles.

The SR 49 CMCP study area is between the junction of Interstate 80 (I-80) and SR 49 in the city of Auburn in Placer County and the junction of State Route 20 (SR 20) and SR 49 in the city of Grass Valley in Nevada County.
