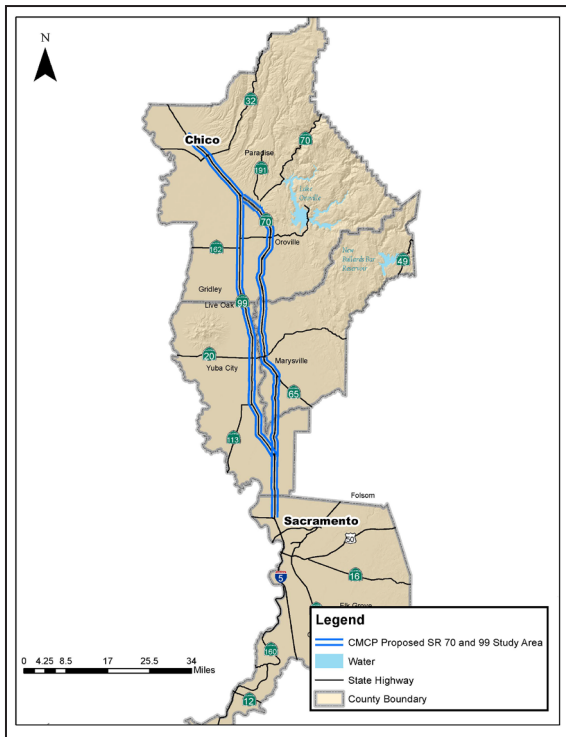

The State Routes 70-99 Comprehensive Multimodal Corridor Plan (SR 70-99 CMCP) will help Caltrans and our partners establish a unified vision for the corridor as one complete transportation system connecting communities, jobs, services and healthy lifestyles.

Study Area

The SR 70-99 CMCP study area is on SR 70 from the SR 99 Jct. in Sutter County to the SR 149 Jct. in Butte County; SR 99 from the I-5 Jct. in Sacramento to Chico; and on SR 149 in Butte County.
