Sound Wall Removal/Relocation – All Sections Rebuilt!


As part of the SM 101 Express Lanes Project, Caltrans relocated sections of sound walls in the City of San Mateo, adjacent to northbound U.S. 101. The sound walls were rebuilt to their previous lengths and heights. Additional activities, such as restriping, may occur on city streets near the completed sections of sound wall in the future as part of the project. However, Caltrans does not plan to remove sound walls in any other locations for this project. The locations where sound walls were relocated are shown on the aerial photos below.

Sound Wall Removal/Relocation Locations:


Newbridge Avenue to Just Past Dakota Avenue (Complete)

Removal of the sound wall on South Bayshore Boulevard adjacent to U.S. 101, from Newbridge Avenue to just north of Dakota Avenue, began April 2020. This section of the sound wall has been rebuilt and is now complete.



2nd Avenue to Dore Avenue (Complete)

Removal of the sound wall on South Bayshore Boulevard adjacent to U.S. 101, from 2nd Avenue to Dore Avenue, began March 2020. This section of the sound wall has been rebuilt and is now complete.



Dore Avenue to East Poplar Avenue (Complete)

Removal of the sound wall on North Bayshore Boulevard adjacent to U.S. 101, from Dore Avenue to East Poplar Avenue, began April 2020. This section of the sound wall has been rebuilt and is now complete.
