SR-92 IN SAN MATEO COUNTY

Caltrans is partnering with the San Mateo County Transportation Authority and City/County Association of Governments of San Mateo County to implement improvements serving the US 101 and State Route (SR) 92 interchange. The project construction is funded with approximately \$45 million in local Measure A, regional, and federal funds.

Construction work will begin in Spring of 2025 and is expected to be completed in the Summer of 2028.

Caltrans will minimize traffic impacts by utilizing overnight work where possible.



The project will provide safety and operational improvements at four locations. These will improve traffic flow and safety, reduce hazardous movements, and improve local access to and from U.S. 101. The proposed interchange modifications will result in operational improvements, enhancement to local access, and promotion of economic vitality. The proposed work will also notably improve merge and weave areas, improving safety conditions for all users of the highway system. The four improvement locations are:

- Improvement 1: south loop ramp and structure modifications on SR-92 west to US 101
- Improvement 2: merging area and restriping on US 101 to SR-92 east
- Improvement 3: off-ramp improvements on US 101 south to Fashion Island Blvd.
- Improvement 4: off-ramp and intersection modifications at US 101 north at Hillsdale Blvd.
