SO WHAT IS HAPPENING?

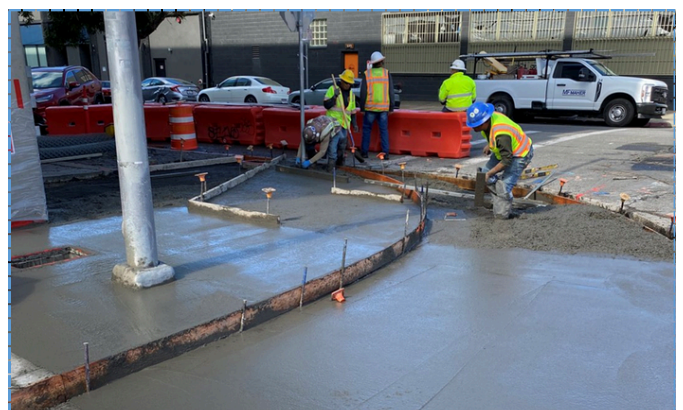
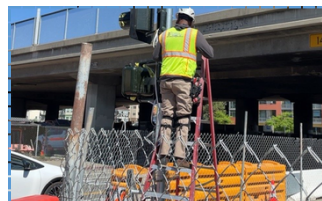
Safety enhancements are underway along Oak Street from 2nd to 9th Streets, and improvement work inside the Webster Tube began on April 6 with an estimated six-month duration. Crews are progressing as planned, and our Public Information Office is actively coordinating updates with nearby residents, businesses, and community partners.

WHAT IS BEING WORKED ON NOW?

Crews are continuing safety upgrade work along Oak St. Vegetation clearing at 5th street and Jackson St has taken place to prepare the area for the future horseshoe ramp. Crews have been excavating, forming, and pouring foundations, to anchor and support new roadway features such as traffic signal poles, signs, and utilities. As ramps and sidewalks are completed, they will reopen to the public.

Inside the Webster Tube, crews have installed temporary lane striping, removed handrails from the maintenance walkway and sections of tunnel tile, and poured new concrete curbs.

Currently, crews are drilling and bonding steel dowels to tie the new concrete into the existing tunnel and will continue curb and striping work. Survey teams are also mapping utilities and equipment locations, including future call-box sites. This work prepares the maintenance walkway, which will become the new bike-ped walkway once completed, which will be built in sections.

On Mariner Square Loop in Alameda, crews have set safety barriers and installed temporary striping; Crews are laying out the new sidewalk, marking existing irrigation, and clearing & grading to build a solid base before concrete is placed.

Caltrans is coordinating with AC Transit and prioritizing work near bus stops so those stops can be restored as soon as safely possible.
