elcome to this installment of the State Route—29 (SR-29) Pavement Rehabilitation and Complete Street Project Newsletter.

There's a lot happening along SR-29, and we're excited to share the progress with you. Alleyways are being filled, new lighting is going up, and crews continue patching potholes to keep the route smoother and safer until full paving begins this spring.

As work moves forward, we'd like to highlight a key feature you'll see along the corridor: **bulb-outs**. So—what exactly are they?

A bulb-out occurs at intersections where pedestrians prepare to cross the road. The curb is extended out creating a narrow road way allowing pedestrians to have a shorter path of travel from one side of the road to the other. The bulb out also makes pedestrians more visible to motorists and encourages motorists to slow down.


