

Limekiln Creek Bridge Replacement Geotechnical Investigation

There will be a geotechnical site investigation for the Limekiln Creek Bridge Replacement project located on State Route 1 from postmile 20.95 to 21.3 in Monterey County. The bridge components require a subsurface investigation to determine soil and rock conditions by drilling a vertical boring, performing in-situ soil testing, collecting soil and rock samples for laboratory testing, and developing a subsurface profile. There will be six (6) borings, five (5) of which will be drilled from the Limekiln Creek Bridge bridge deck and will require a one way lane closure with flagging.



Duration: From September 21 - November 20, 2026.

Expected noise: About 96.6 dBA. About as loud as a lawnmower, power tool, or snowmobile.

Campsite Closures: September 21 - October 30, sites 4-12 only. Day use will remain open throughout the duration of the drilling.
