



# US 101 North Buellton Pavement Project

Santa Barbara County | Updated June 2026

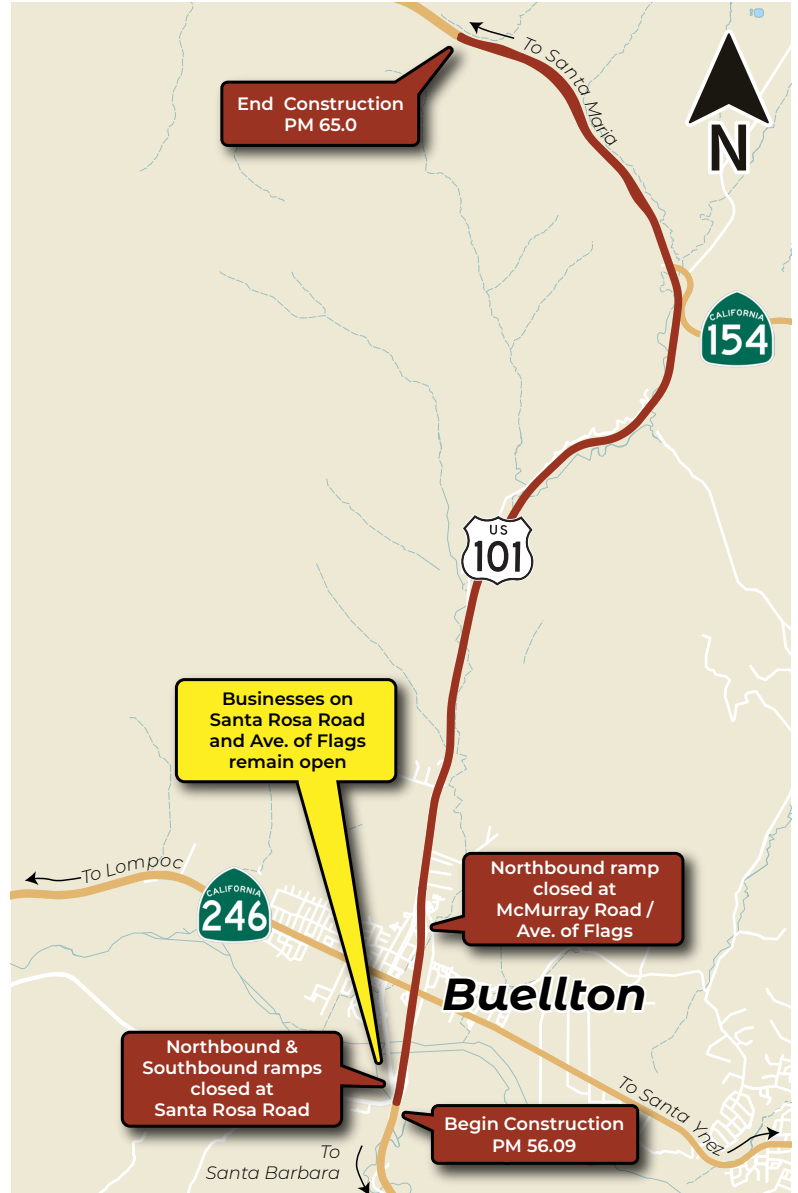
This work is part of a project to maintain roughly ten miles of US 101, in addition to the reconstruction of shoulders, replacement of concrete pavement, overlaying of existing asphalt, ramp reconstruction, drainage repair work, electrical upgrades, and the installation of new guardrails throughout to provide more reliable travel conditions for years to come.

## Current Traffic Impacts

- US 101 reduced to one-lane in each direction from the Nojoqui Creek Bridge to just north of Avenue of Flags.
- Northbound & southbound Santa Rosa on/off ramps and northbound on ramp at McMurray Rd. / Avenue of Flags will be closed until August 13, 2026.

Caltrans advises motorists to use a short detour that takes them onto Highway 246 during the closures. Businesses in the area remain open. Access to businesses on Santa Rosa Road is from Avenue of Flags.

We appreciate your patience and cooperation during this important infrastructure improvement. Updates will be provided on future closures.
