MORRO BAY PAVEMENT PROJECT


DESCRIPTION

The project proposes to preserve 34.38 lane miles of pavement using a Capital Preventive Maintenance (CAPM) strategy: grind 0.10' of existing pavement and overlay with 0.15' of Rubberized Hot-Mix Asphalt (RHMA). Additionally, the project proposes to replace census/signal loops, replace minor drainage, upgrade guardrail and median Thrie-Beam, replace roadway signs, replace light poles, add bike lanes at signalized intersections, and upgrade curb ramps to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

PURPOSE


To preserve and extend the service life of the existing pavement, restore other roadway facilities that are in poor/fair condition and upgrade curb ramps to ADA compliant standards.

It is anticipated that one or more virtual public outreach meetings will be held throughout the CEQA process to allow the public an opportunity to provide feedback on the project, the first of which will be in late summer/early fall 2024.
