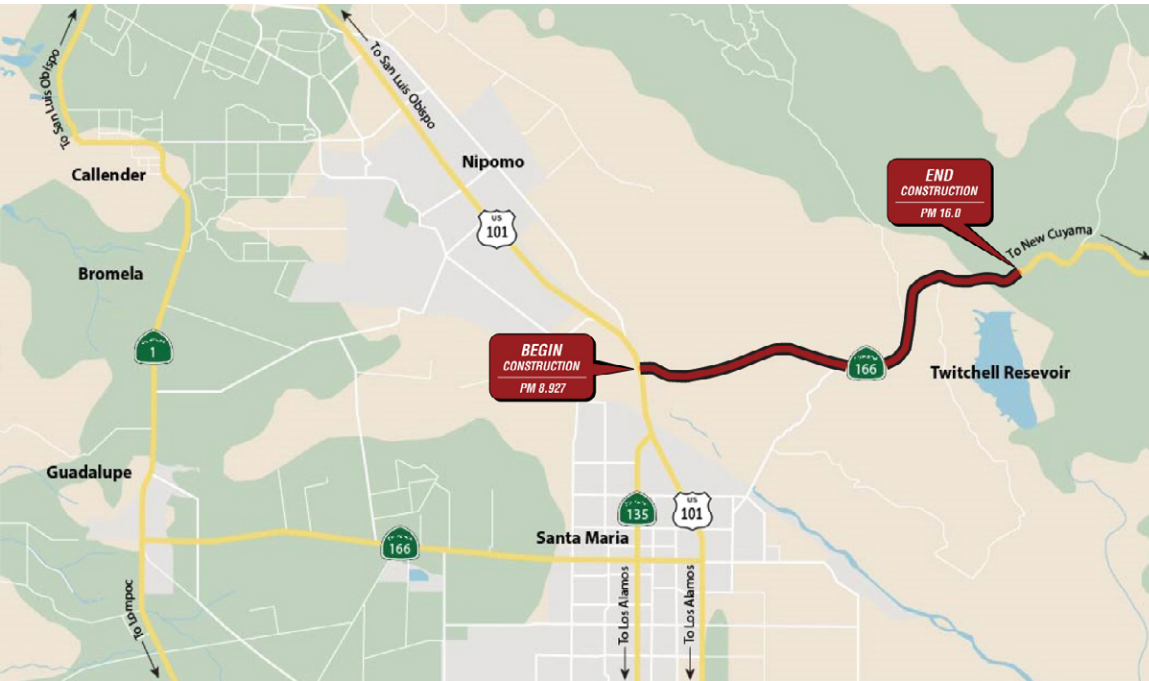


San Luis Obispo Highway 166 CAPM

San Luis Obispo County – Route 166 – Post Mile 8.927/16.0



Description

The San Luis Obispo Route 166 Capital Preventive Maintenance (CAPM) project is located on Route 166 from the junction of Route 101/166 to just west of the Husana River Bridge. The project will include the preservation of over 14 miles of Class 3 pavement, restoration of 2 drainage systems, and upgrading of 5 guardrail locations to the Manual for Assessing Safety Hardware (MASH) standards.

Purpose & Need

The purpose of this project is to improve the ride quality, multi-modal mobility, and equity on Highway 166. This will be done through preserving and extending the service life of the pavement, restoring culverts in poor condition to maintain the drainage system and avoid flooding and erosion, and replacing guardrail to meet MASH standards. The need for these improvements is to prevent continued deterioration, which could lead to service disruptions through Route 166 and more frequent maintenance activities.
