

Bridge Rail Replacement at Rocky Creek Bridge

Monterey County - Highway 1 - Post Mile 60.1

Description

The Bridge Rail Replacement at Rocky Creek Bridge is located in Monterey County at Rocky Creek Bridge. The project will involve replacing existing nonstandard bridge rail and approach railing with approved MASH (Manual for Assessing Safety Hardware) compliant railing. It intends to preserve the integrity of the character-defining features and historical significance of Rocky Creek Bridge.

Purpose & Need

The purpose of this project is to upgrade existing nonstandard bridge railing to current standards, in order to ensure the reliability of Highway 1. The project is needed because the reinforced concrete barrier rail has deteriorated with exposed rusted reinforcement bars, severe cracking, and unsound concrete. Due to this, Rocky Creek has been identified as one of the Big Sur bridges to upgrade.
