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Purpose & Need

The Los Alamos Connected Community Project will provide constructed pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure for 0.9 miles of SR 135 to connect residential areas to the downtown community corridor and Olga Reed Elementary School in Los Alamos. Gaps in existing sidewalks and bike lanes, sight-distance challenges, and a lack of designated crosswalks deter people from walking or biking between residential areas and downtown amenities. This project will reconnect the community whereby driving would not feel like the only viable option to access between the east and west sides.

Benefits

The Los Alamos Connected Community Project will benefit the community by increasing walking and bicycling, dedicating space for bicyclists, providing new intersection lighting, and providing a safe, convenient and comfortable active transportation corridor for people of all ages, abilities, and incomes. It will also provide safe routes to school and safe routes for seniors.
