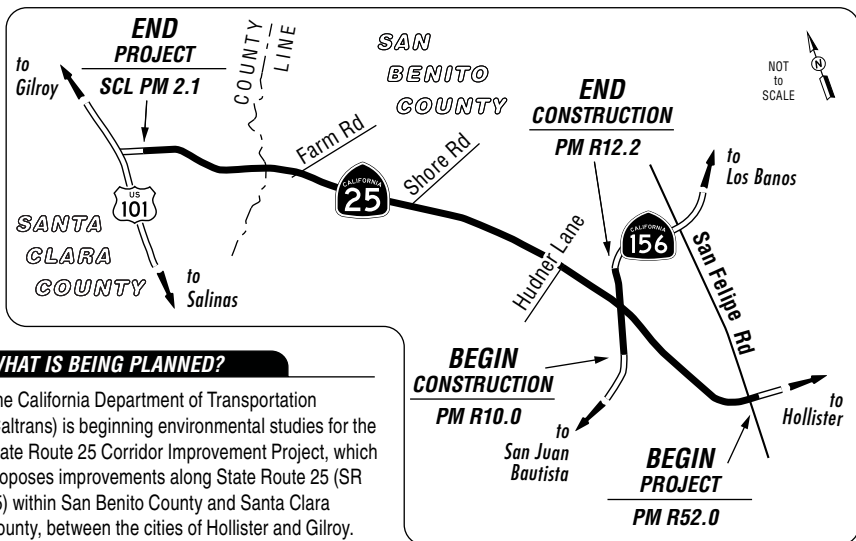
State Route 25 Corridor Improvement Project

SCOPING PERIOD EXTENDED

The scoping period deadline has been extended from December 12, 2024, to December 31, 2024. Your input regarding the scope of the Environmental Impact Report, environmental factors potentially affected, and project alternatives must be submitted to Caltrans no later than 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, December 31, 2024. No further revisions have been made to the Notice of Preparation.

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is beginning environmental studies for the State Route 25 Corridor Improvement Project, which proposes improvements along State Route 25 (SR 25) within San Benito County and Santa Clara County, between the cities of Hollister and Gilroy.

WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?

This public notice serves as an announcement that Caltrans will extend the public comment period from December 12, 2024, to December 31, 2024. Four public scoping meetings were held to:

- Provide a project introduction and an overview of considered alternatives
- Provide an opportunity for public comments on the scope of project alternatives and environmental documentation
- Inform meeting attendees about the upcoming draft environmental document preparation, project timeline, and future opportunities for public input
