Route 246 CAPM and Bridge Replacement Project

In Santa Barbara County in and near the City of Lompoc on Highway 246 and Buellton from State Route 1 to just east of the Domingus Road intersection.

Work Description:

Preserve 22 lane miles of Class II pavement, rehabilitate drainage, upgrade sign panels and guardrail, install ADA curb ramps, create a pedestrian path from State Route 1 to River Park Road, and replace the Santa Ynez Bridge with a bridge raised above flood levels with wider shoulders that can safely accommodate vehicles, bicycles, and pedestrians.

Project Cost: \$58,240,000

Preserve just over 27 lane miles of Class II pavement using Rubberized Hot Mix Asphalt overlay strategies including cold planing or shoulder backing, rehabilitate drainage, replace signage and sections of guardrail, rehabilitate/ reconstruct curb ramps, and install complete streets features including shoulder widening and bicycle conflict marking.
