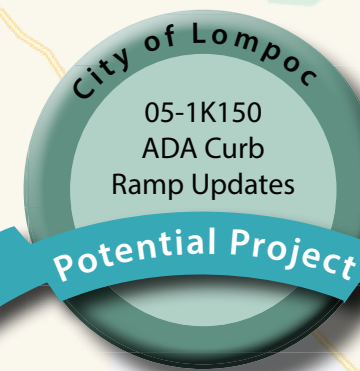

Lompoc CAPM

In the City of Lompoc at combined segment of Route 246 and Route 1, on Route 246, from west of V St. to H St. and on Route 1, from H Street to 12th St.

Work Description

Upgrade ADA curb ramps, cold plane pavement and place Hot Mix Asphalt pavement.

Route 246 CAPM and Robinson Bridge

In and near the City of Lompoc and Buellton, from Route 1 to just east of the Domingus Rd. Intersection.

Work Description

Preserve 22 miles of Class 2 pavement, rehabilitate drainage, replace TMS elements, upgrade sign panels and guardrail, and replace Santa Ynez Bridge with a bridge raised above flood level with wider shoulders that can safely accommodate vehicles, bicycles, and pedestrians.

Project Cost: \$96,099k
