
BIG SUR REGENT'S SLIDE UPDATE

August 22, 2025

CREWS CONTINUE TO WORK 7 DAYS A WEEK

ESTIMATED REOPENING DATE TO BE RELEASED LATE-SEPT.

3,500 SHEAR DOWELS HAVE BEEN INSTALLED



IN RECENT NEWS:

Thousands of shear dowels (60 ft. steel bars) are being drilled and grouted into the cut slope above the active working area. Since mid-July, crews have installed an additional 1,500 dowels, bringing the overall total number of installed shear dowels to 3,500. Shear dowels mitigate further slide activity providing immediate and long-term protection.

Excavation work is advancing with the combined use of both conventional and remote-controlled equipment. Favorable weather has allowed crews to continue working 7 days a week.

Caltrans will announce an estimated reopening date for Highway 1 at Regent's Slide in mid-September.
