State Route 99 Selma to Fowler Rehab Project: Southbound State Route 99 at Merced Avenue on-ramp scheduled to re-open to the traveling public

FRESNO COUNTY- Caltrans is scheduled to re-open the Merced Avenue on-ramp to southbound State Route 99 near the City of Fowler in Fresno County. The re-opening is scheduled to occur the morning of November 17, 2022.

With the re-opening of the Merced Avenue on-ramp to southbound State Route 99, Caltrans announces the closure of the Manning Avenue on-ramp to southbound State Route 99. The closure of this on-ramp is scheduled until mid-February 2023.

To ensure the safety of workers and motorists, southbound State Route 99 at Manning Avenue offramp will remain closed as crews continue to work on the project. This closure is scheduled until mid-February 2023.

Manning Avenue to southbound State Route 99 On-Ramp Detour:

Motorists that would normally use the southbound State Route 99 Manning onramp are encouraged to travel eastbound Manning Avenue, turn right onto Golden State Boulevard, turn right onto Highland Avenue and then follow signage to State Route 99.

This SB-1 funded project is located in the State Route 99 corridor located near the City of Selma and the City of Fowler from McCall Avenue Undercrossing to a half mile north of Merced Street Undercrossing.

The project replaces the lanes in the northbound and southbound State Route 99 including widening the shoulders with reinforced concrete paving which will extend the roadway life and help minimized future maintenance and ramps along the project area will be reconstructed.

The project includes replacing and adding new culverts that cross SR-99, upgrade all signs and update ADA ramps, replace all existing guardrail, and electrical work.
