Comments will be accepted from March 3, 2026, to April 2, 2026.


If there are no major comments or requests for a hearing, Caltrans will proceed with the project's design.

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to repair and replace existing drainage culverts in Kings County on State Routes 33, 41, 43, 198, and 269.

WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?

Caltrans has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show the project will not significantly affect the quality of the environment. The report explains why it is called an Initial Study with Proposed Negative Declaration. This notice is to inform you of the preparation of the Initial Study with Proposed Negative Declaration and of its availability for you to read and provide comments. This notice also offers you an opportunity to request a public hearing.
