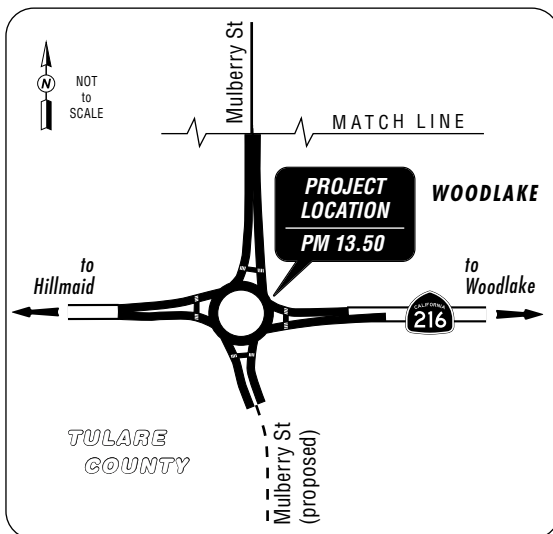
If there are no major comments or requests for a meeting, Caltrans will proceed with the project's design.

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), in cooperation with the City of Woodlake, proposes to construct a roundabout at Mulberry Street and State Route 216 (Naranjo Boulevard) at Post Mile 13.5 in the City of Woodlake in Tulare County.

WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?

Caltrans, in cooperation with the City of Woodlake, has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show the project will not significantly affect the quality of the environment. The report that explains why is called an Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration. This notice is to inform you of the preparation of the Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration and of its availability for you to read and comment on. This notice also offers you an opportunity to request a public meeting and provide comments.
