HOW WILL THE INFORMATION BE USED?

Information from the surveys will be used to estimate the availability of person of color- and woman-owned businesses for Caltrans contracts and procurements.

WHO WILL BE CONTACTED?

Businesses that do work or provide services related to the types of professional services, transit services, non-professional services, construction, and goods that government agencies contract for may be contacted, even if they have never worked with government agencies in the past.
