By the Numbers

The Caltrans Office of Civil Rights (OCR) sets small, disadvantaged, and disabled veteran business project goals, certifies Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBEs), oversees the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Infrastructure Program, analyzes data, develops the workforce, provides outreach and supportive services to level the playing field and provide equal opportunities for ALL.

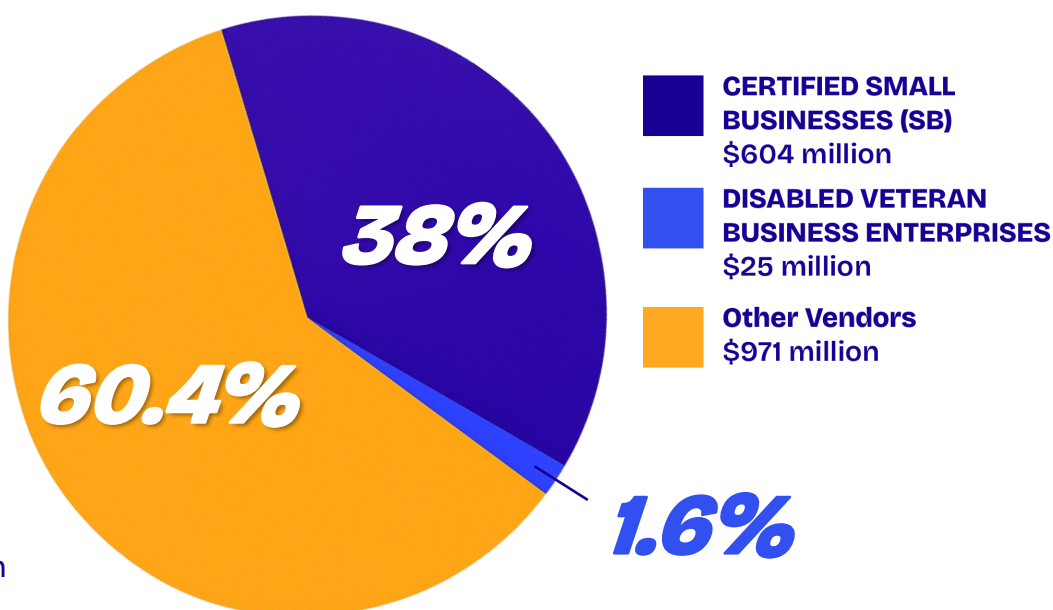
Due to the Interim Final Rule (IFR), the percentage of work committed to DBE firms is currently **0%**.

The DBE program will relaunch, without regard to race or gender, once Caltrans reevaluates its DBE goals in accordance with 49 CFR §26.111.

State Contracting Participation as of March 31, 2026

As of March 31, 2026, Caltrans spent nearly \$1.6 billion on state contracts and purchasing for SFY 2025–26.

Of that total, DVBEs received nearly \$25 million, or 1.6%. Certified Small Businesses (SB) were awarded more than \$604 million — nearly 38% — surpassing the 25% state participation goal outlined in SB 1 and AB 1919.

DBE REEVALUATION UPDATE

Key Takeaways

Caltrans and the California Unified Certification Program (CUCP) completed the initial evaluation required by the federal Interim Final Rule (IFR), which now mandates an individualized review of social and economic disadvantage for every Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) certified before October 3, 2025.

Where things stand now

- As of July 17, 2026, 27% of Caltrans-certified DBEs submitted the required Personal Narrative (PN).
- Over 2,300 firms still need to file, including 33.9% of DBEs currently performing on active contracts.
- Coordinating CUCP-wide materials to ensure consistent instructions statewide.

What Caltrans is doing

- Conducting direct outreach to non-filing firms with active work.
- Providing simplified PN guidance for sole proprietors and microbusinesses.
- Offering supportive services webinars for sectors showing larger drop-offs.
- Coordinating CUCP-wide materials to ensure consistent instructions statewide.

What to expect next

- As firms better understand the PN process and receive additional support, Caltrans anticipates increased filing rates and stabilization of the DBE pool.
- The department will continue offering guidance, training, and one-on-one support throughout the reevaluation period.
- Goal-setting will be adjusted to align with the updated DBE pool.
- CUCP partners remain confident in long-term recovery and continued resilience of California's DBE community.
