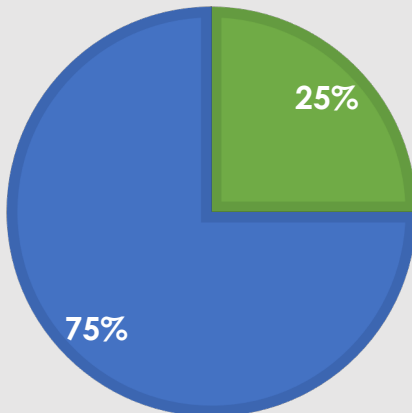

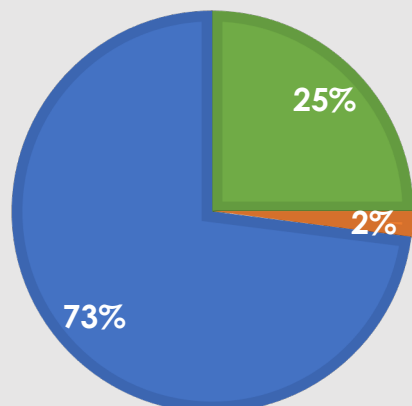

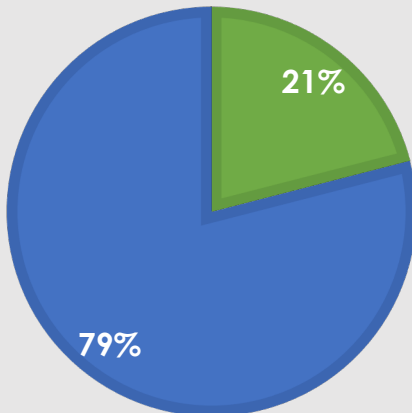

Participation at a glance:

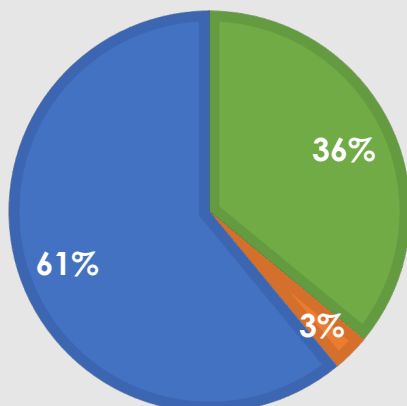

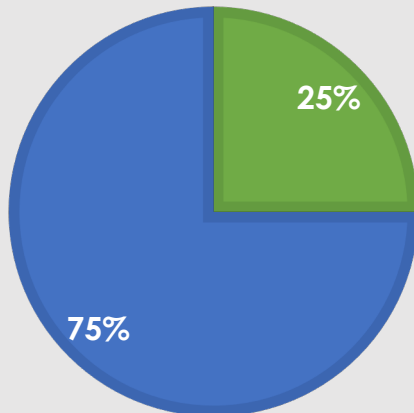

Participation at a glance:

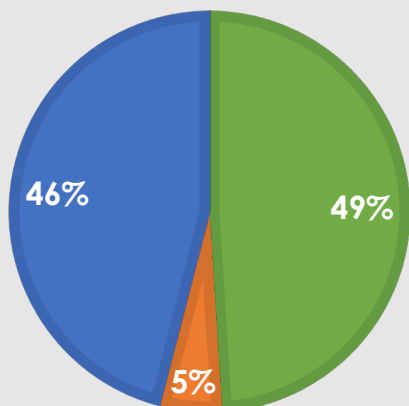
## FEDERAL MAJOR CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS TOTAL \$375,338,313

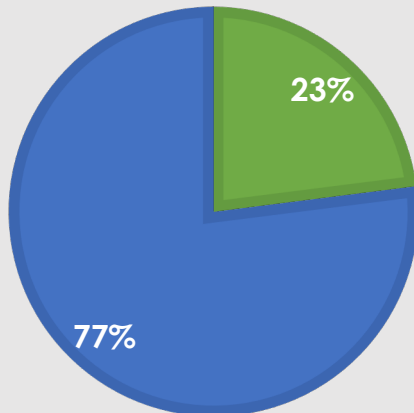

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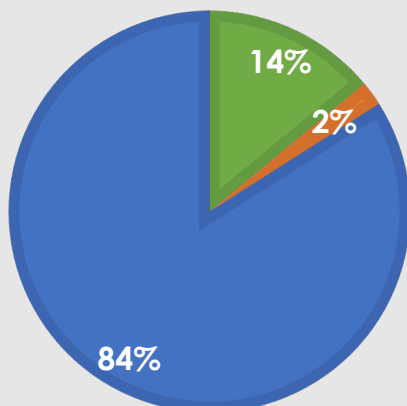
## FEDERAL MAJOR CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS TOTAL \$300,817,144
