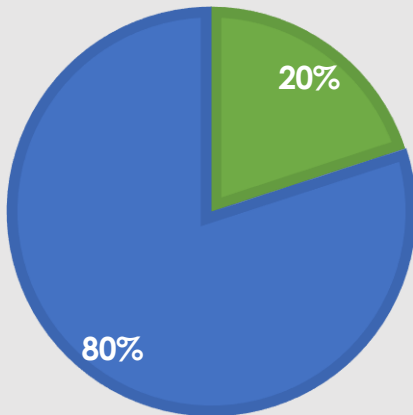

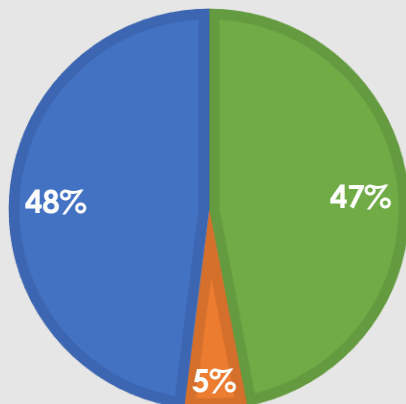

- District 5 recently filled the District Small Business Liaison Position. We continue to respond to interest inquires and anticipate outreach programs to begin soon.

DISTRICT DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

District 5 continues to be devoted to contracting to Small Businesses, especially in our Minor B and Emergency Contract programs. The following contracts were written in the last few months.

- An emergency force account contract for \$388,000 to Access Limited Construction a Certified Small Business of Arroyo Grande, CA to clear rockfall catchments at various locations in Santa Barbara and San Luis Obispo Counties.
- Another emergency force account contract for \$388,000 to KCI Environmental a Certified Small Business of San Luis Obispo, CA to address the landscaping at the Marsh Street gore area in the city of San Luis Obispo.
- Two open bid projects were awarded to two Certified Small Businesses. The first was for the installation of a CMS sign on Highway 246 in Santa Barbara County to P.T.M. General Engineering Services, Inc. of Riverside, CA in the amount of \$348,500. The second was for installation of a CMS sign on Highway 1 in San Luis Obispo County to Lee Wilson Electric of Arroyo Grande, CA in the amount of \$195,500.

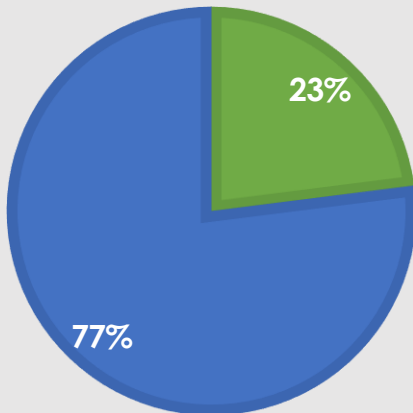

District 6 DBE, SB, and DVBE Participation at a glance:

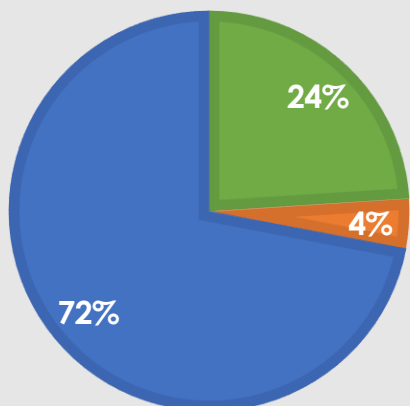
FEDERAL MAJOR CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS TOTAL \$43,957,617

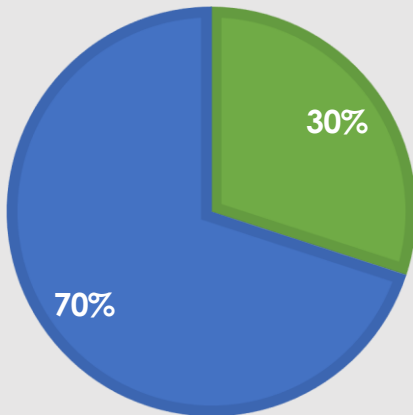

District 7 DBE, SB, and DVBE Participation at a glance:

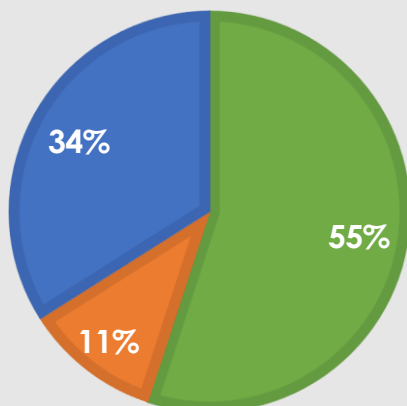
FEDERAL MAJOR CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS

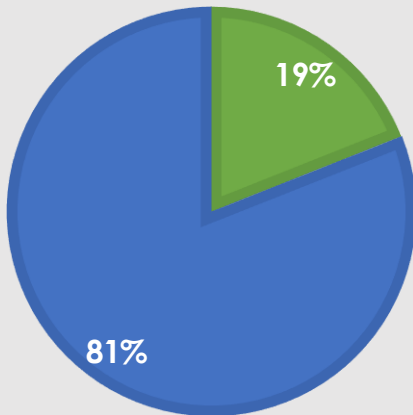

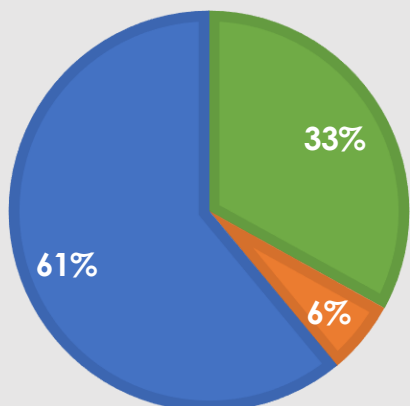
FEDERAL MAJOR CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS
