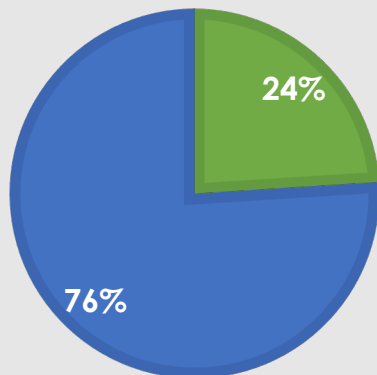

Participation at a glance:

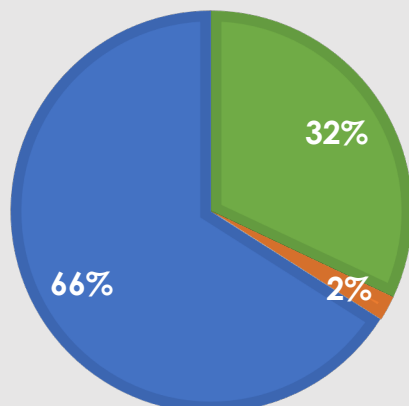

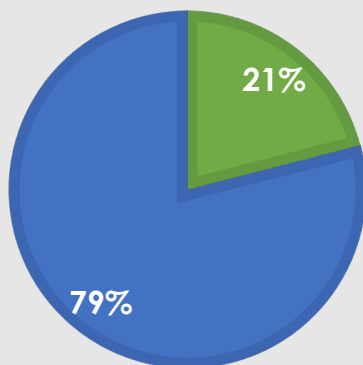

Participation at a glance:

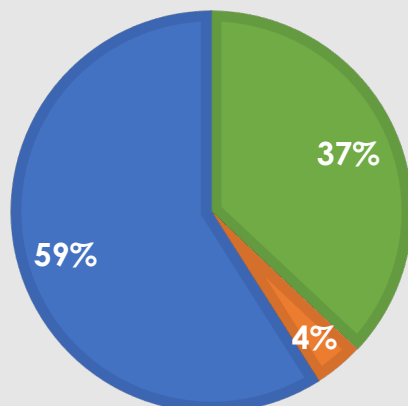

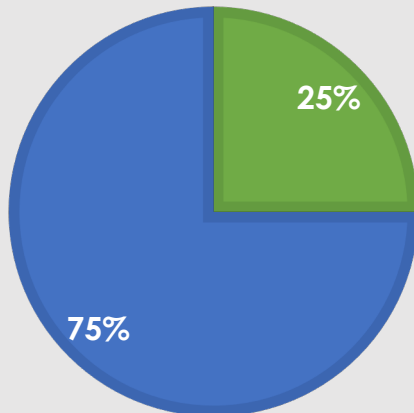

Participation at a glance:

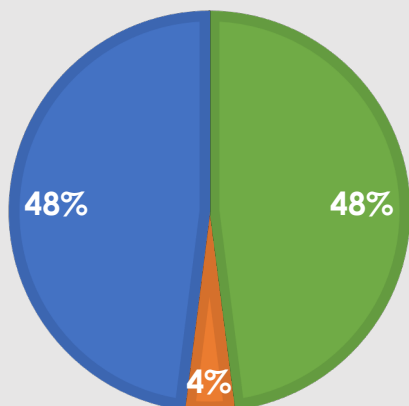
FEDERAL MAJOR CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS TOTAL \$414,513,520

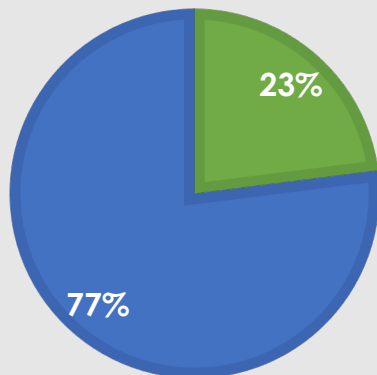

Participation at a glance:

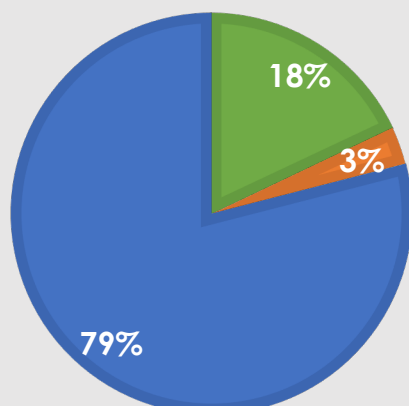
FEDERAL MAJOR CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS TOTAL \$308,328,969
