Subject: SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS FOR PAVEMENT SMOOTHNESS DATA

This directive describes new requirements for resident engineers to submit pavement smoothness data when smoothness incentive and disincentive specifications are included in a California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) project. Resident engineers must submit the hot mix asphalt pavement or concrete pavement smoothness pay adjustment spreadsheet file used to determine acceptance and the applicable payment adjustments for each lane, as well as the accompanying ProVAL Project data files.

Submit these files to the email address for hot mix asphalt pavement or concrete pavement within 10 business days of including the smoothness payment adjustment in the progress estimate. Submit the same files to the email address within 10 business days of approving a contractor's smoothness acceptance request for grinding existing concrete pavement.
