

DIRECTIVE

Until further notice, unsheltered encampment cleanups are **only allowed** if there is an immediate safety concern or a local partner has identified safer spaces for unsheltered individuals to move indoors. Given the continuing spread of the COVID-19 virus and the vulnerability of the unsheltered population, districts should contact CHP and local partners, including local public health departments, regarding additional COVID-19 guidance and protocols that may be necessary before any further cleanups or emergency removals. Displaced individuals who might otherwise have avoided the virus could be unintentionally put in harm's way after an abatement and, if forced to move, the transient nature of homelessness could result in those individuals coming into contact with many other people.

In addition, and until further notice, districts are to use hazmat (biowaste) contractors to perform emergency removals and will not send employees to remove any remaining trash or debris.

This policy shall be revisited on July 31, 2020.

Procedure: Any proposed unsheltered encampment cleanup must be approved by the HQ Deputy Director of Maintenance and Operations. Districts must immediately notify the HQ Deputy Director of Maintenance and Operations (through their chain of command) of any requests for an unsheltered encampment cleanup.
