Subject: CONSTRUCTION PROJECT FUNDING IDENTIFICATION SIGNS

This directive announces the implementation of new construction project funding identification signage requirements by change order for projects that were advertised either with the existing project funding sign requirements or without a project funding sign. Project funding signs have been updated to include the current federal funding program Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act and replace the State Highway SB-1 funding signs with a new "Rebuilding California" logo.

Division of Traffic Operations has adopted the following new project funding identification signs for use on projects:

- C48A(CA) Use when the project is funded by state highway funds only. Revised to allow use of up to 4 local agency logos. Replaces existing sign C48(CA).
- C49A(CA) Use when the project is funded by Clean California funds only. Revised to allow use of up to 4 local agency logos. Replaces sign C49A(CA).
- C49C(CA) Use when the project is funded by Clean California funds and state highway funds. Replaces sign C49B(CA).
- C50A(CA) & C50B(CA) Use when the project is funded by federal highway funds and state highway funds. Replaces signs C47B.
- C51(CA)- Use when the project is funded by local funds only. Revised to allow use of up to 4 local agency logos. Replaces sign C47A.

Section 12-3.11B(5)(b), "Construction Project Funding Identification Signs," of the special provisions has been developed for project funding sign requirements. New sign details for project funding identification signs are available at:

Project funding signs are to be installed as soon as practical on projects where the signs have not been installed. For projects where the funding signs have already been installed the existing signs may remain in place. For recently awarded contracts resident

engineers should use the new Section 12-3.11B(5)(b) of the special provisions to determine the type of project funding signs required. For contracts without project funding signs or with the old project funding sign requirements shown in Section 12-3.11B(5)(a), implement the new funding sign requirements by change order.

A sample change order memorandum and sample change order are attached to this directive. This directive serves as delegation of authority from the Division of Construction, except when the change order language is altered. The change order will not affect the controlling activity; so no time adjustment is warranted.
