These changes related to the current FHWA policy are effective on all projects where the project initiation document is to be approved on or after January 1, 2021; however, district may choose to implement earlier than this date if they so choose.

The locations of revisions are denoted by a vertical line within the outside margin of the manual.

Some of the references found in the PDPM have hyperlinks that connect to Caltrans intranet pages which are not displayable to the general public. Until such time that the specific reference becomes available on the internet, the user will have to contact their district liaison, Caltrans project manager, or the appropriate Headquarters division to inquire about the availability of the reference.

PDPM holders are encouraged to use the most recent manual version available on-line at the above website. Should a manual holder choose to maintain a paper copy, the holder is responsible for keeping their paper copy up to date and current.
