NEW MEMO TO DESIGNERS (MTD) 12-9 DESIGN CRITERIA FOR

TEMPORARY PREFABRICATED MODULAR STEEL PANEL TRUSS BRIDGES

Effective immediately, MTD 12-9 Design Criteria for Temporary Prefabricated Modular Steel Panel Truss Bridges constitutes the design provisions for temporary prefabricated modular steel panel truss bridges constructed within the state right-of-way.

For projects under development, adoption of the MTD 12-9 is:

- Not applicable when the Plans, Specifications, and Estimate (PS&E) have been submitted for advertising, or, the project is under construction.
- Optional if it would not impose a significant delay in the project schedule or a significant increase in the project engineering or construction costs. The project history notes and plans must indicate the design criteria used.
- Mandatory for all projects with scheduled "Ready-to-List" dates (as defined in FY 2018-2019 Delivery Plan) after January 1, 2019.
