

Manufactured Products Containing Steel or Iron	Additional Construction Materials
 Precast products – 100% subject to Buy America All other manufactured products – 90% subject to Buy America 	All materials – 100% subject to Buy America
 Must be melted/manufactured in the United States 	 Must be manufactured in the United States
 Minimal use threshold – 0.1% of total bid or \$2,500 (whichever is greater) unchanged 	No minimal use threshold
COC from manufacturer or producer	COC with attestation statement of manufacturing process

Subject: BUY AMERICA

In November 2021, the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act was signed into law. This act included the Build America, Buy America Act, which expands federal Buy America requirements. The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has addressed these requirements in a standard special provision that will be edited and used in each project's plans, specifications, and estimates submitted to the Division of Engineering Services – Office Engineer as of November 10, 2022. These corresponding contracts' special provision requirements will replace Section 6-1.04, "Buy America," of the Standard Specifications. Ongoing construction contracts, without the standard special provision, will continue to require the Buy America requirements for steel and iron materials or products only, and no change orders will be written to incorporate modified requirements on these contracts. This directive seeks to provide contract administration guidance on the expanded Buy America requirements.

The expanded federal Buy America requirements apply to:

- · Steel or iron materials
- · Manufactured products containing steel or iron
- Additional construction materials, namely:
- Nonferrous metals
- Plastic or polymer-based products
- Glass
- Lumber
- Drywall

Special Considerations



Buy America does not apply:

- Temporary work
- Tools or construction equipment
- Existing project materials or products that are modified or moved to another location on the same project

Ensuring Success



- Discuss Buy America requirements at the Preconstruction Conference
- CEM-3101 "Notice of Materials to be Used"
- Share information with subcontractors
- Reduce impact on project delivery
- A minimum of one, more likely two, iterations of Buy America requirements over the next 2 to 18 months.


California Legislation



Buy Clean California Act (AB-262)

- Signed into law: October, 2017
- Took effect: July, 2019
- Establishes the maximum acceptable GWP based on industry average of facility-specific GWP emissions for a given material
- Requires EPD submittals for applicable materials



6-1.06 BUY CLEAN CALIFORNIA ACT 6-1.06A Summary

2023 Standard Specs

For projects with a total bid over \$1 million and 175 or more original working days, the materials or products shown in the following table are subject to the Buy Clean California Act (Pub Cont Code § 3500 et seq.):

Material or product	Material specifications
Carbon steel rebar ^a	Section 52-1.02B, "Bar Reinforcement"
_	Excludes epoxy-coated or galvanized reinforcement uses.
Structural steel ^b	Section 55-1.02D(1), "General," – Structural Steel and Other
	Materials tables and Section 99, "Building Construction."
_	For hot-rolled, plate or hollow materials.
Flat glass ^c	Section 99, "Building Construction"
Mineral wool board insulation ^d	Section 99, "Building Construction"

^aFor each mill providing 20,000 pounds or more on the project.



^bFor each mill providing 5,000 pounds or more on the project.

^cFor each manufacturer providing 2,000 square feet or more on the project.

dFor each manufacturer providing 4,000 square feet or more on the project.



Standard Specifications



2023 Standard Specs

For carbon steel rebar material subject to Buy Clean California Act, the source mill must be on the Authorized Material List for Buy Clean California Act compliant steel mills. Identify source mills on Notice of Materials to be Used form submittals.

For structural steel, flat glass, and mineral wool board insulation subject to Buy Clean California Act, submit an environmental product declaration for each applicable material or product at least 15 days before scheduled installation. The global warming potential of each applicable material or product as evidenced by its environmental product declaration must not exceed the maximum acceptable global warming potential values established by the Department of General Services. Do not install the applicable material or product until the submittal has been authorized. The maximum acceptable global warming potential for each category of material or product is published on the Department of General Services website at:

What We Need to Know



Contractor's Role

- CEM-3101 Notice of Materials to be Used Form
 - Carbon Steel Rebar, Structural Steel, Flat Glass, Mineral Wool Board Insulation
- Submit applicable EPDs through DIME
 - Register with DIME <u>at least 15 days before submitting</u>
- Ensure quantity data has been input on DIME within 5 business days of shipment receipt at project site.
- Confirm applicable manufacturers are on the <u>Authorized</u> <u>Material List</u>.
- Comply with Section 6-1.06 of the Contract Special Provisions and Standard Specifications

Caltrans Role

- Discuss EPD requirements at the Pre-Con meeting
- Review of EPD submittals <u>Engage your METS Rep!</u>
- Verify the reported GWP is within published limits
