## **FARMLANDS DECISION TREE**



Caltrans, after receiving response from NRCS (or after 30 days with no response) determines avoidance, minimization, and/or mitigation measures if there are adverse effects to farmlands. If the total points from the Form CPA-106 or FORM AD-1006 is less than 160, no other alternatives need be considered. If the score is over 160, additional alternatives must be considered that would lessen the adverse effects to farmlands.

The final NEPA document or determination must include evidence of coordination with the NRCS and a copy of the completed Form CPA-106 or Form AD-1006. A copy of the completed form indicating the selected alignment should also be sent to the NRCS.
