Program Summary

The Low-Carbon Transportation Materials Grants Program Funding (LCTM) program is a discretionary program that focuses on accelerating the use of materials and products that have lower levels of embodied greenhouse gas emissions.

Note: This program has two NOFOs: one for State applicants and one for non-State applicants. This factsheet focuses on non-State applicants.

Eligibility

Eligible Applicants

Non-State Applicants: metropolitan planning organizations, local governments or agencies, Federally recognized tribes, Federal Lands Management Agencies, and other agencies

Eligible Projects

Federal-aid highways, Tribal transportation facilities, Federal lands transportation facilities, Federal lands access facilities.

Cost Sharing:

Funds are eligible for up to 100% Federal share, LCTM funds may only be applied to eligible activities associated with the use of the low carbon transportation material.
