Notes:

The current transportation act (IIJA) ends with FFY 2025/26. At the moment, there are no drafts of the next act that covers 2027 FSTIP/FTIP periods.

Estimated Apportionment reflects the total federal CMAQ/STBGP amount for California. Adjusted Distribution reflects the amount available to MPOs after SPR and oversight deductions.

MPOs should not program beyond their 4 year estimate, which helps prevent over programming.

1. FFY 2026/27 assume no new transportation in effect by 10/2026 and extends FFY 2025/26 apportionments. FFY 2027/28 through FFY 2029/30 assume a past 10 year average growth of new transportation acts and ongoing years.

2. FFY 2026/27 through FFY 2029/30 assume FFY 2025/26's funding & suballocation rate of 55% to Region. Of the amount to be distributed to Regions based on population, assume 81% to > 200K and 19% to rest of State.

3. TAP Set Aside: Continues the IIJA trend, based on state share from 2009 with a steady 1.6% average increase.

4. Additional distribution to Regions: Is an adjustment to get the State/Local split at the 60/40 total and will be adjusted as needed.

Distribute remainder based on 2026 STIP County Share Formula.

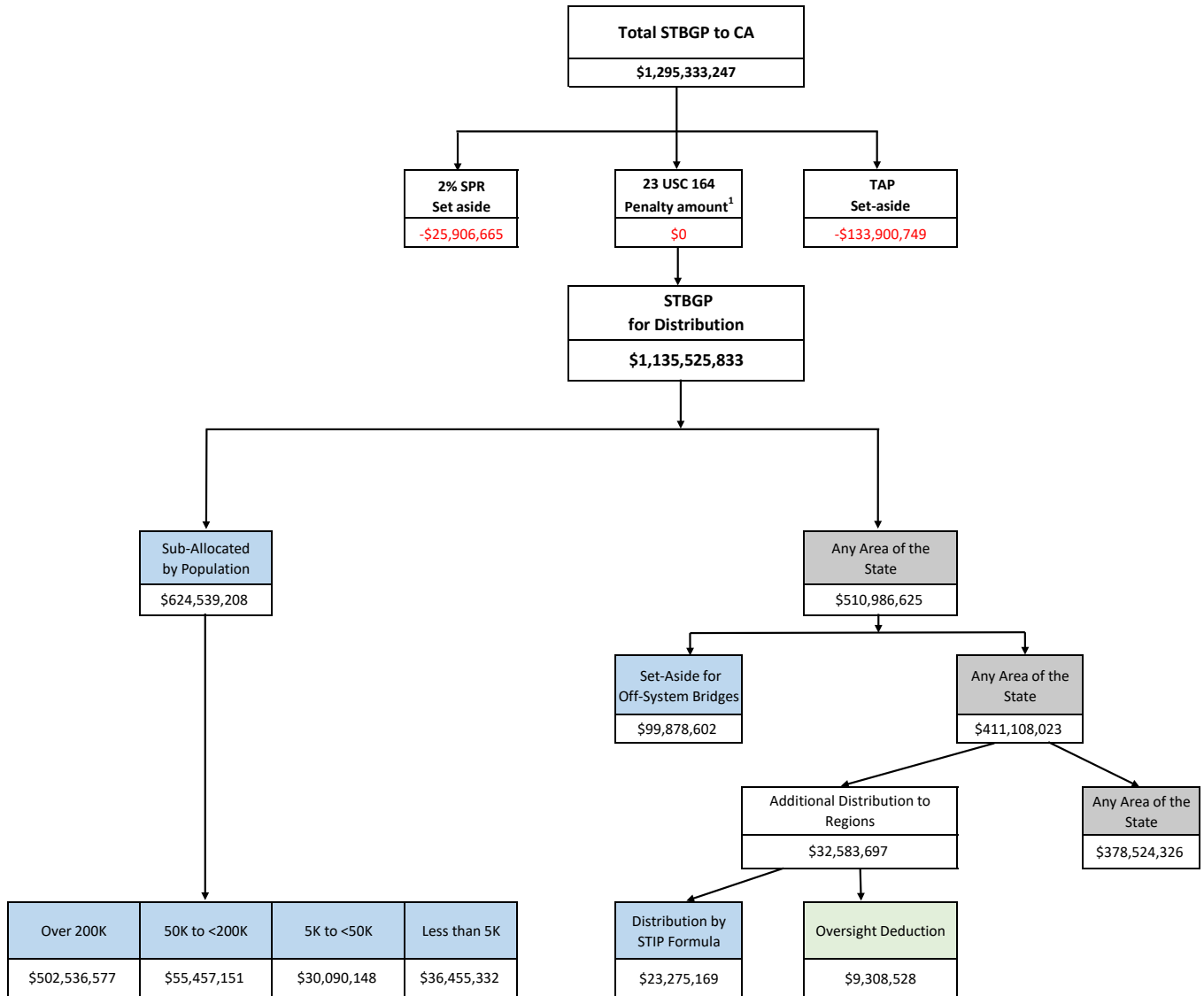
5. Local Assistance oversight estimate: assume 5% increase per year.

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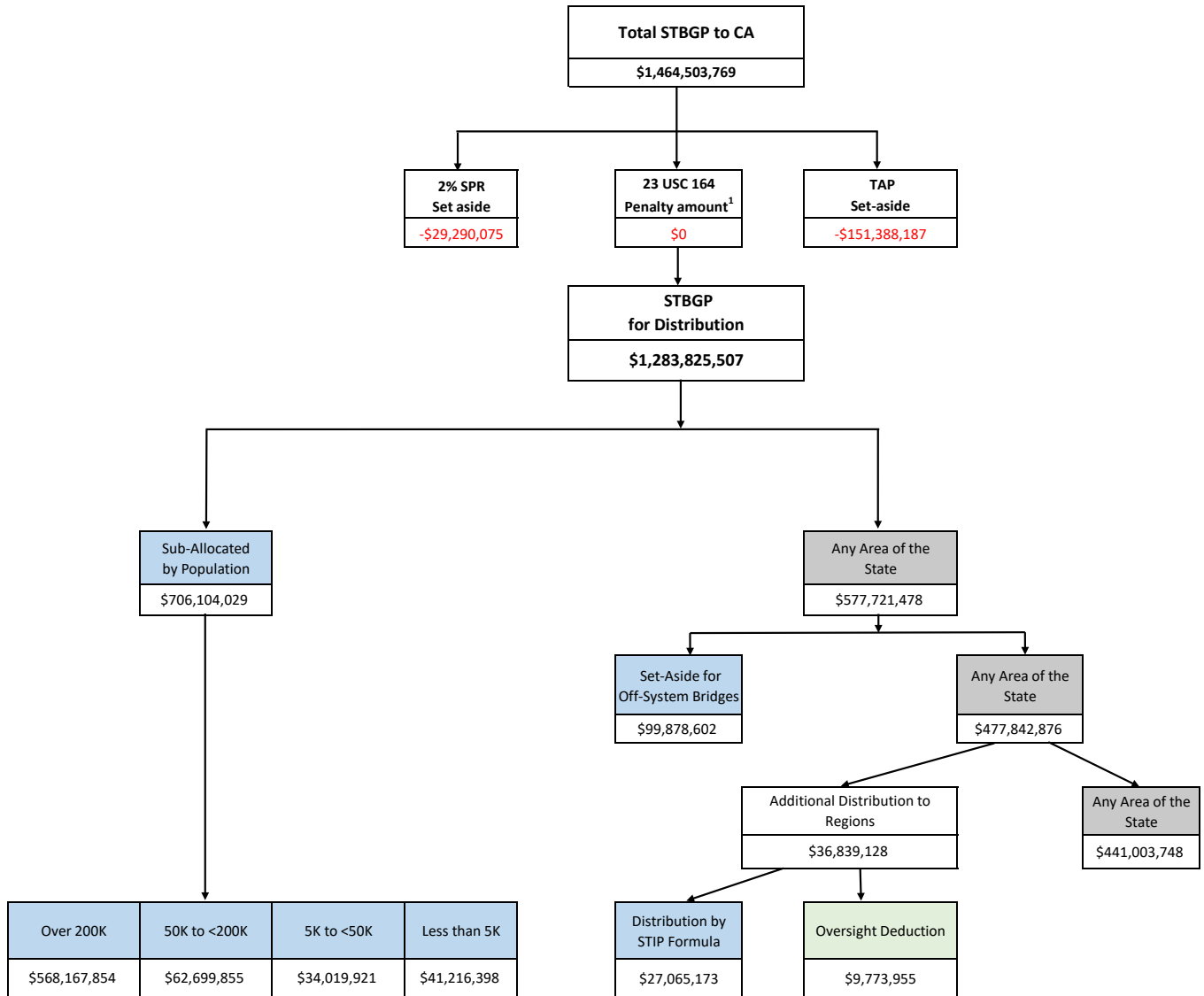

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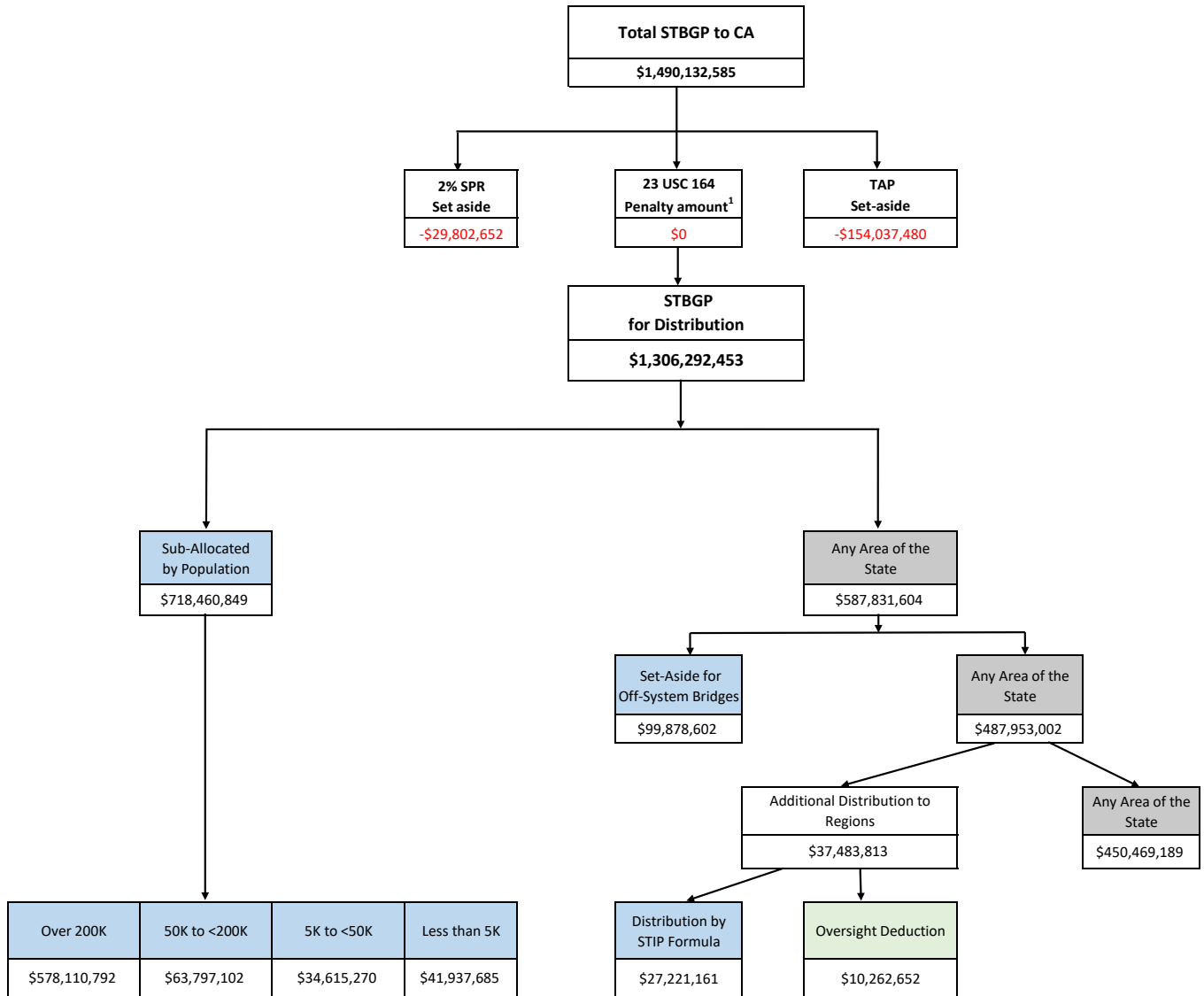

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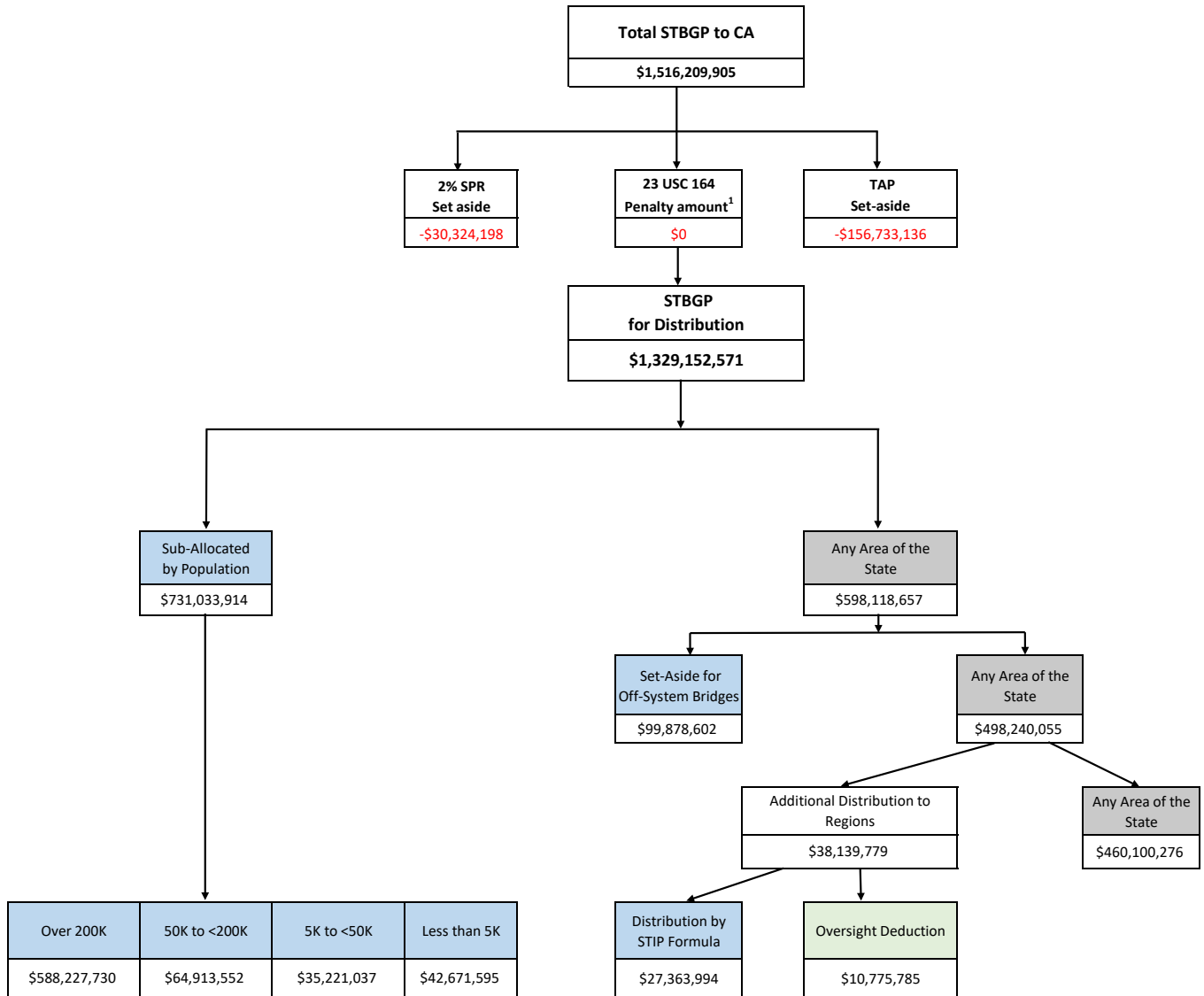
