Federal Updates

White House Updates:

- **July 17, 2026** – US House of Representatives released a proposed continuing resolution (CR) that would keep the government funded at FY 2026 levels through December 4, 2026.
- **June 15, 2026** – US DOT Secretary Duffy and the Build America Bureau are investing \$46.97 million across 27 states to build infrastructure projects with help of public-private partnerships (P3s).
- **June 9, 2026** – US DOT Secretary Duffy announced a \$626.7 million investment into America's infrastructure, prioritizing large-scale projects over \$150 million.
- **June 3, 2026** – The House Appropriations Committee approved its FY 2027 Transportation, Housing and Urban Development (THUD), and Related Agencies Appropriations Bill.
- **May 17, 2026** – The House Transportation and Infrastructure (T&I) Committee released their draft text of the next surface transportation reauthorization bill.
