- <sup>1</sup> The Locals' estimated base federal fiscal year (FFY) 2017-18 (FFY 2018) Obligation Authority (OA) is using the final FFY 2016-17 amount provided by our Department's Office of Federal Resources (OFR) as shown on the September 30, 2017 OA delivery report. This amount will be revised as additional information is made available. On April 16, 2018, the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) released the OA for the full FFY (FHWA N4520.253).
- <sup>2</sup> Balance of FFY 2017 OA (last FFY's OA balance) -- This is the amount a Region/Program must pay back if over delivered or the amount a Region/Program will receive to "make whole" if under delivered based on the Division of Local Assistance's (DLA's) OA Management Policy. Amounts shown in parenthesis are amounts owed and positive (non-parenthesis numbers) amounts are to be repaid to Regions/Programs. Please see September 30, 2017 OA delivery report for details on this amount.
- <sup>3</sup> Required by Sections 182.6(n) and 182.7(k) of the California Streets and Highways Code. The distribution of the estimated oversight amount is based on the FFY 2017 actual apportionments for the Bridge and Safety Programs and the FFY 2018 estimated apportionments for the CMAQ and RSTP Programs.
- <sup>4</sup> Received agreements during FFY 2018 from Region(s) for the Local Streets and Roads (LS&R) Statewide Needs Assessment Funding Concurrence.
- <sup>5</sup> This is the FFY 2018 adjusted estimated base OA, which includes adjustments for FFY 2017 OA over or under delivery, the FFY 2018 Estimated Oversight Adjustment and the LS&R Needs Assessment.
- <sup>6</sup> Balance of FFY 2018 estimated OA per date of report -- This is the running balance of FFY 2018 estimated OA. At the end of the FFY, this is the amount a Region/Program must pay back if over delivered or the amount a Region/Program will receive to "make whole" if under delivered based on DLA's OA Management Policy. Amounts shown in parenthesis are owed back and positive (non-parenthesis numbers) amounts are owed to those Regions/Programs. If OA is lost to the State due to DLA under delivery as a whole, under delivered OA may not be available to repay Regions and/or Programs.
