- <sup>1</sup> The Locals' estimated base FFY 2018 OA is using the Draft amount provided by our Department's Office of Federal Resources (OFR) dated May 1, 2018. This amount will be revised as additional information is made available. On April 16, 2018, the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) released the OA for the full FFY (FHWA N4520.253).
- <sup>2</sup> Balance of FFY 2017 OA (last FFY's OA balance) -- This is the amount a Region/Program must pay back if over delivered or the amount a Region/Program will receive to "make whole" if under delivered based on the Division of Local Assistance's (DLA's) OA Management Policy. Amounts shown in parenthesis are amounts owed and positive (non-parenthesis numbers) amounts are to be repaid to Regions/Programs. Please see September 30, 2017 OA delivery report for details on this amount.
- <sup>3</sup> Required by Sections 182.6(n) and 182.7(k) of the California Streets and Highways Code. The distribution of the estimated oversight amount is based on the FFY 2017 actual apportionments for the Bridge and Safety Programs and the FFY 2018 estimated apportionments for the CMAQ and RSTP Programs.
- <sup>4</sup> Received agreements during FFY 2018 from Region(s) for the Local Streets and Roads (LS&R) Statewide Needs Assessment Funding Concurrence.

- <sup>6</sup> Balance of FFY 2018 estimated OA per date of report -- This is the running balance of FFY 2018 estimated OA. At the end of the FFY, this is the amount a Region/Program must pay back if over delivered or the amount a Region/Program will receive to "make whole" if under delivered based on DLA's OA Management Policy. Amounts shown in parenthesis are owed back and positive (non-parenthesis numbers) amounts are owed to those Regions/Programs. If OA is lost to the State due to DLA under delivery as a whole, under delivered OA may not be available to repay Regions and/or Programs.
- <sup>7</sup> In November 2017, project 5031(027) for \$850,000 was erroneously charged against the Santa Cruz RSTP funds instead of the RIP funds held by the State. This error is corrected in the March 2018 reports.
