Dear Ms. Konove:

Under the provisions of Section 125, Title 23 of the United States Code, this is a Letter of Intent by the California Department of Transportation to request Emergency Relief (ER) funds to assist in the cost of repairing damages on Federal-aid highways in California caused by a series of winter storm events.

Beginning on December 28, 2023, winter storms bringing damaging winds, substantial precipitation, widespread flooding, and debris flows impacted Humboldt, Monterey, San Diego, and Ventura counties. The precipitation, snowfall and flooding caused damage to and forced the closure of roads and highways in the impacted counties.

The initial preliminary damage estimate is currently at \$70.8 million for the State facilities, subject to increase. There are no reported Local damages at this time. The preliminary damage estimate information is being gathered by the State and Local agencies affected. Additional information will be provided with the subsequent ER Application under Disaster CA24-2 December 2023 Winter Storms.

Under separate cover, the Office of Federal Resources will be submitting the ER Application, along with the Governor's Proclamation(s) and Damage Survey Summary Report, to provide the Division Administrator with a basis to make a finding that the disaster is eligible for ER funding.
