Dear Mr. Baca:

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has reviewed the application for Emergency Relief funds for disaster event CA25-4 dated October 14, 2025, as required under 23 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 668.111(c) and (d). FHWA has determined that the event meets the requirements established under 23 United States Code (USC) 125 and is eligible to receive Emergency Relief funding. The Governor's Proclamation included in your application for Emergency Relief funding identified Los Angeles County.

Per 23 CFR 668.113(a), please submit a Program of Projects for this disaster event by January 23, 2025. The Program of Projects will constitute the current list of sites authorized for Emergency Relief funding under disaster event CA25-4.

The effective disaster event start date for this disaster event CA25-4 is December 9, 2024. Damage Assessment Forms (DAFs)/Detailed Damage Inspection Reports (DDIRs) must be submitted by November 28, 2025.

Per 23 CFR 668.105(h), all Emergency Relief projects associated with this event are expected to advance to construction authorization by September 30, 2027.
