4. Financial Status

HBP Managers shared the current FFY 24/25 report as of 6/4/2025 with the following points:

- HBP has \$563 million of apportionment available this FFY between core apportionment and BFP funds.
- De-obligations to date are approximately \$13.6 million, which provides additional capacity.
- \$387 million has already been obligated since the start of the FFY and there is an additional \$12 million in the pipeline to be obligated.
- HBP is on pace when compared to prior year delivery.

- OA is currently at 89%. HBP is confident in meeting 100% OA delivery this year.
