LOCAL AGENCY PROJECT ON SHS

- Local Agency Administered
 - Caltrans provides oversight
 - Encroachment Permit/DEER
 - Local agency may request additional support from Caltrans
 - Defined through Co-Operative Agreement
 - PM may be assigned based on project complexity
 - Caltrans invoices Local Agency per Co-Op



LOCAL AGENCY PROJECT ON SHS

- Caltrans Administered
 - Coop outlines Caltrans's Role
 - Provides general oversight + provides support identified in Coop
 - Fund Type – [Local](#)/[Federal Subvention](#)/[ATP/SB1/STIP](#)
- Federal Subvention Funds
 - Local Federal funds given to Caltrans for administering the project through the subvention reimbursement process



FEDERAL SUBVENTION FUND PROJECT

- Project Set-up
- Funding Requests
- Agreements (Master, Supplemental Agreement etc.,)
- Invoices / Inactivity – invoice every 6 months
- Project End Date (PED)
- Cooperative Work Agreement (CWA) / Budget Authority Replenishment (BAR)
- Project Closeout



FEDERAL SUBVENTION FUND PROJECT

- Project Set-up
 - EA for Oversight created by Caltrans Project Management (CTPM)
/District Project Control
 - Adv ID in AMS created by CTPM
 - Locode – 62XX
- Funding Requests
 - Specify all funding sources (e.g., local demo funds, RSTP, CMAQ)
 - Authorizations for local funds through Local Assistance
 - Finance Letter (Federal funds and eligible items, local match)



FEDERAL SUBVENTION FUND PROJECT

- Agreements (Coop, MA, PSA)
- Invoices
 - Processed by CTPM /Accounts Payable
 - Inactivity – invoice every 6 months
 - Repeat Inactive Projects – not invoiced over 24 months
- Project End Date (PED)
 - Defines the period of reimbursable work on a project
 - Depends on the Project Phase
 - PE (PAED+PS&E) - M500 + 6 months, Construction – M800



FEDERAL SUBVENTION FUND PROJECT

- PED cont...
 - Two Step Process
 - Update M800
 - Request PED extension through Local Assistance (FADS submittal)
 - Use HQ PED tool to track PEDs on subvention projects

FEDERAL SUBVENTION FUND PROJECT

- CWA/BAR – by phase
 - CWA - Cooperative Work Agreement extends BA beyond 6 years
 - Add 2 more years, giving a total of 8 years of BA
 - BAR – Budget Authority Replenishment
 - One time replenishment after CWA
- Project Closeout
 - Follow CTPM closeout process
 - Inform Local Assistance of Project Closeout
 - LA will closeout in LP2000



FEDERAL SUBVENTION FUND PROJECT

- Project Delivery Status Meetings
 - DLA Quarterly Project Delivery forum
 - PM can attend to get additional project support
 - Local Agency May be able to join in the future
 - Attended by Dist. & HQ Local Assistance and FHWA
