EXHIBIT 12-G REQUIRED FEDERAL-AID CONTRACT LANGUAGE (For Local Assistance Construction Projects)

The following language must be incorporated into all Local Assistance Federal-aid construction contracts. The following language, with minor edits, was taken from the 2010 Caltrans Standard Specifications, Revised Standard Specifications issued by Caltrans Office Engineer, and the Code of Federal Regulations.

DBE Program: Activities During Construction



- Monitoring and Enforcement
 - Commercially Useful Function
 - Trucking
 - Prompt Payment
- Substitutions





Commercially Useful Function

A DBE performs a commercially useful function when it is responsible for execution of the work of the contract or a distinct element of the work…by actually performing, managing, and supervising the work involved.

49 CFR 26.55





Commercially Useful Function

A DBE subcontractor...

- Supervisor exclusively employed by the DBE
- Must perform 30% of the work with its own workforce
- Must not share employees with non-DBE (particularly the Prime.)

Commercially Useful Function A DBE supplier...

- maintains an inventory of supplies (some exceptions);
- negotiates the price, places the order (quantity), and pays the manufacturer; and
- sub takes possession of the supplies





Commercially Useful Function:

A DBE Trucking Company...

- must manage and supervise entire trucking operation.
- must own and operate at least one truck.
- must use DBE drivers or lease DBE trucks to receive full DBE credit.

Commercially Useful Function: Trucking

- Monitor the trucks to ensure enough DBE trucks are being used to meet the DBE commitment.
- Cross check load tickets with monthly trucking report.



DBE Program: Monthly Reports



Commercially Useful Function: Trucking

Before the 15th day of each month for the previous month's work, submit:

- Monthly DBE Trucking Verification form
- Monthly DBE Payment form

What if another firm is performing work that is supposed to be performed by a DBE?

- Notify prime ASA suspected
 - Verbally and in writing
- Document in daily report
- Don't suspend work!

CM Chapter 8-3, DBEs





- Contractor must in writing
 - Notify orig. DBE of intent to use other forces or material sources.
 - Provide the reason.
 - Provide 5 business days for DBE to protest being substituted.

Reasons:

DBE...

- 1. Fails/refuses to execute a written contract;
- 2. Fails to meet bond requirements;
- 3. Is not licensed;
- 4. Fails/refuses to perform the work;
- 5. Work is unsatisfactory and not in compliance;
- 6. Suspended or debarred;

Reasons: (cont.)

DBE...

- 7. Becomes bankrupt/insolvent;
- 8. Voluntarily withdraws in writing;
- 9. Ineligible to receive credit for the type of work required;
- 10. Owner dies or becomes disabled;
- 11.Department determines other documented cause per 49 CFR 26.53.





Contractor's request must include:

- 1 or more of the reasons listed in the specs.
- Notices from you to the DBE regarding the request.
- Notices from the DBE to you regarding the request.

- Approve DBE substitution only for specifically listed reasons
- Prime must replace DBE with another DBE or make adequate GFE
- Substitute DBE must perform at least the same dollar amount of work as the original DBE under the Contract to the extent needed to meet the DBE goal

- All <u>sub</u>contractors must be paid within 7 days.
 - Prime to Sub
 - Sub to Sub

Local Assistance Procedures Manual EXHIBIT 9-B Local Agency DBE Annual Submittal Form (Attachment) Prompt Payment of Withheld Funds to Subcontractors Federal regulation (49 CFR 26.29) requires one of the following three methods be used in federal-aid contracts to ensure prompt and full payment of any retainage kept by the prime contractor or subcontractor to a subcontractor. Please check the box of the method chosen by the local agency to ensure prompt and full payment of Method 1: No retainage will be held by the agency from progress payments due to the prime contractor. Prime contractors and subcontractors are prohibited from holding retainage from subcontractors. Any delay or postponement of payment may take place only for good cause and with the agency's prior written approval. Any violation of these provisions shall subject the violating contractor or subcontractor to the penalties, sanctions, and other remedies specified in Section 7108.5 of the California Business and Professions Code. This requirement shall not be construed to limit or impair any contractual, administrative or judicial remedies, otherwise available to the contractor or subcontractor in the event of a dispute involving late payment or nonpayment by the contractor, deficient subcontractor performance and/or noncompliance by a subcontractor. This clause applies to both DBE and non-DBE subcontractors. Method 2: No retainage will be held by the agency from progress payments due to the prime contractor. Any retainage kept by the prime contractor or by a subcontractor must be paid in full to the earning subcontractor in 30 days after the subcontractor's work is satisfactorily completed. Any delay or postponement of payment may take place only for good cause and with the agency's prior written approval. Any violation of these provisions shall subject the violating contractor or subcontractor to the penalties, sanctions, and remedies specified in Section 7108.5 of the California Business and Professions Code. This requirement shall not be construed to limit or impair any contractual, administrative or judicial remedies, otherwise available to the contractor or subcontractor in the event of a dispute involving late payment or nonpayment by the contractor, deficient subcontractor

performance and/or noncompliance by a subcontractor. This clause applies to both DBE and non-DBE

Method 3: The agency shall hold retainage from the prime contractor and shall make prompt and

The prime contractor or subcontractor shall return all monies withheld in retention from all subcontractors within 30 days after receiving payment for work satisfactorily completed and accepted **including incremental acceptances of portions of the contract** work by the agency.

The Agency does not pay for work listed on the Local Agency Bidder DBE Commitment form (15-G), unless it is performed or supplied by the listed DBE or an **authorized** substitute.

DBE Exercise 1

You are the RE on a project and have been provided an award package that contains, among other things, the following documents:

Exhibit 12-B Bidders List of Subcontractor's (DBE and Non-DBE)

Exhibit 15-G Construction Contract DBE Commitment

<u>Part 1.</u> As required, the Contractor has submitted a Subcontractor Request form (Exhibit 16-B) for your approval. Decide as a group if you will approve it or return it for corrections. Be prepared to explain your decision.
