2.	Up-to-Date Tester Certifications in Project Files	64%
3.	Quality of Materials Certificates of Compliance	65%
4.	Subcontracting Request Submitted / Approved	67%
5.	Extra Work at Force Account Hours in Daily Reports	70%
6.	Support of Adjustment of Compensation Prices on CCOs	71%
7.	Daily Report Breakdown of Hours by Contract Item / CCO Work	75%
8.	Federal EEO Poster Board Posted in Clearly Visible Location	76%
9.	Controlling Operation of Work Noted on Weekly Statement of WD	78%
10.	Presence / Quality of Buy America Certifications	80%
