Highway Maintenance (HM) projects extend the life of existing infrastructure through preventive and corrective strategies that go beyond routine field maintenance. Caltrans delivers HM work through individual contracts, focusing on repairs—such as pavement overlays, bridge joint seals, and culvert repairs—without upgrading or replacing facilities.

Senate Bill - 146: Job Order Contracting (JOC)

Signed by Governor on July 10, 2023, SB-146 authorizes the use of Job Order Contracting or JOC method for Caltrans.

Authorizes JOC procurement method for projects;

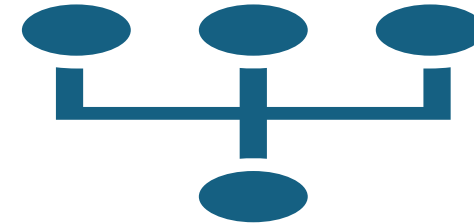
- *Highway maintenance or safety projects...bridge deck sealing, bridge & asphalt pavement overlays, concrete pavement slab work, joint seals, traffic safety devices, rumble strips...(HM1, HM3, HM4 Safety...)*
- *Traffic management and detection systems (HM4-TMS)*
- *Tree removal, clearing & grubbing, culvert installation & repairs (HM2..)*
- *ADA facilities, building maintenance, safety barriers, & stormwater pollution control devices (HM2, HM4, HM5...)*

Based on SB-146 text all HM programs are eligible for JOC.

Innovative Bidding Process

The traditional HM delivery method (Design-Bid-Build) follows a linear process where Caltrans completes the design before bidding out construction, resulting in longer timelines. In contrast, Job Order Contracting (JOC) uses pre-established unit prices and work orders under a master agreement, allowing for quicker delivery of repetitive maintenance work.

Traditional Bidding Process – HM Contracting

- Districts will prepare the Plans, Specifications, and Estimate (PS&E) package. While the in-house unit price estimates for individual work items (e.g., earthwork) will not be disclosed, Caltrans will provide itemized quantities (e.g., 250 cubic yards of earthwork) for use in contractor cost estimating.
- The PS&E package will be advertised through the Division of Engineering Services - Office Engineer and made available on the designated website. Contractors will develop and submit bids based on their own unit prices, which include profit, insurance, and other associated costs.
- The project will be awarded to the lowest responsive bidder. Upon award, Caltrans and the selected contractor will enter into a formal agreement to execute the work. Construction will then proceed to completion.

Job Order Contracting

- Districts will prepare the Invitation for Bid (IFB) package. Caltrans will provide a unit price list for each item (e.g., \$230 per cubic yard of earthwork), which reflects the fixed unit price, including material, equipment, and labor costs.
- The IFB-package will be advertised through the Division of Engineering Services - Office Engineer and made available on the Cal eProcure. Contractors will develop and submit bids based on their stipulated unit prices, which include profit, insurance, and other associated costs.
- The master agreement will be awarded to the lowest responsive & responsible bidder. Upon award, Caltrans and the selected contractor will work on Work Orders. Construction will then proceed to completion.

Invitation for Bid

Caltrans prepares JOC bidding package.

During Advertisement

Contractors interested in bidding will:

- View the project on Cal eProcure , create an account on bidx.com.
- Follow steps in the JOC Electronic Bidding Guide to submit bids.

Caltrans posts:

- Bidder inquiry results, and Addenda and MA agreement amendments to Cal eProcure.
- Conduct mandatory pre-bid meeting (Refer to JOC bidding package).



Bid Open and Award Master Agreement

Contractors submit bids.

Please note that only contractors who attend the pre-bid meeting will be eligible to participate in the bidding process.

Caltrans posts bid summary on Contractors' Corner.

JOC MA will be awarded to the lowest bidder.

Contractors must submit required documents to District and DES OE on time.



Work Order Construction and Closeout

Once MA executed, WOs can be issued as an individual construction contracts

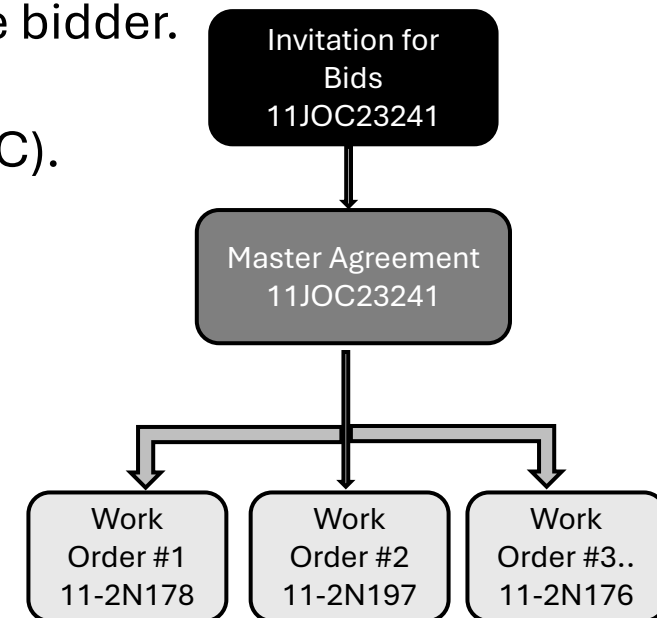
Prior to issuing each WO, Joint Scope Meeting shall be arranged to discuss scope of work, bid items, quantities...

Each WO includes Bid Book (items, quantities, total price), location, Project Plans, Notice to Bidders & Special Provisions

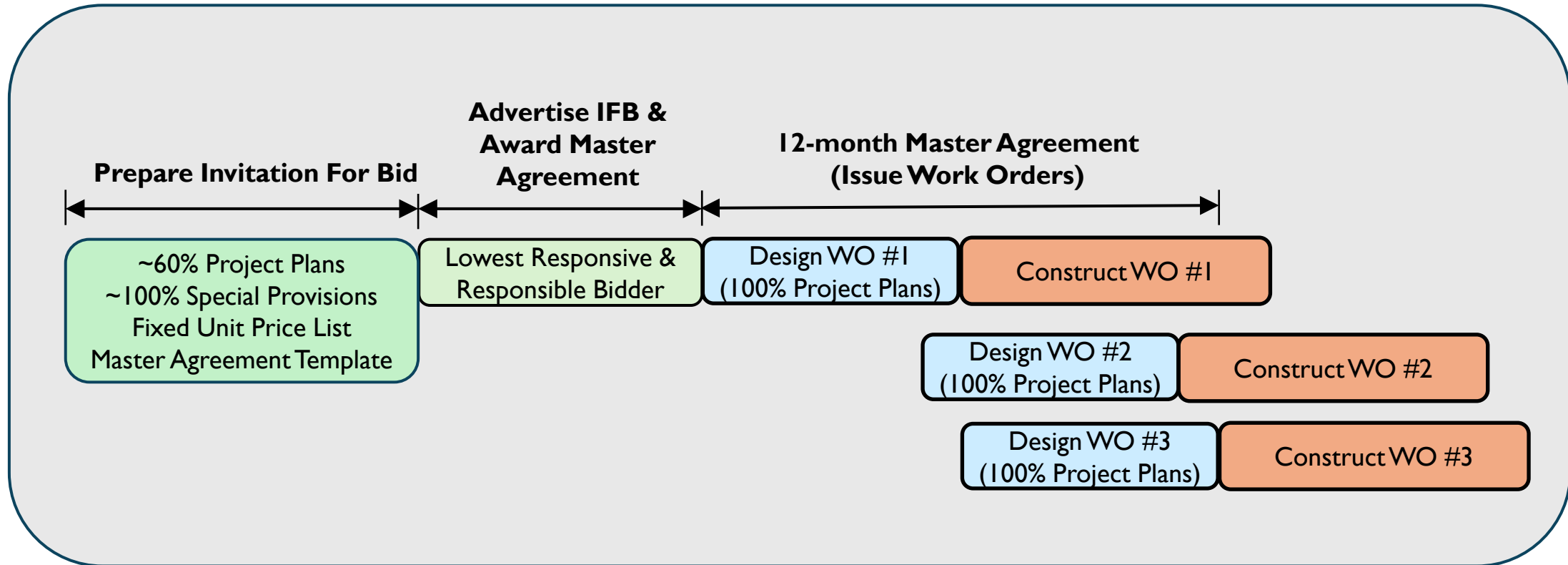
Caltrans works with the contractor to complete construction.

What is Job Order Contracting (JOC)?

- **On-Call Construction Contract:** Utilizes a Master Agreement with multiple Work Orders.
- **Ideal for Non-Complex Projects:** Suitable for repetitive work with minimal design needs.
- **Speed and Efficiency:** Enables rapid delivery with predefined unit prices for maintenance and construction.
- **Multiple Projects under One Contract:** Allows for several projects under a single Master Agreement, improving response times and reducing procurement time/costs.
- **Award Process:** Contract awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.
- **Limitations:**
 - Cannot conflict with existing commercial service contracts (consult DPAC).
 - Multiple JOCs cannot be awarded in the same area for similar work.
- **Example:** Seven HMA thin overlay projects across different locations can be handled under one JOC contract, saving time and costs compared to traditional bidding.







JOC Process



The contractor may perform an indefinite quantity of work, as specified in Exhibit B of the Master Agreement (MA), at the established unit prices during a defined contract period (e.g., 12-month). Work will be issued through individual Work Orders (e.g., WO #1, WO #2), and may take place at various locations. Work Order can be issued/executed on the last day, i.e., before MA expires.

- Project advertised

- IFB advertised
- Price proposal opening
- MA awarded to lowest bidder

Traditional Highway Maintenance (HM) projects: Caltrans advertises the project, opens competitive bids, and awards the contract to the lowest responsible bidder. After issuing a notice to proceed, construction work begins.

Job Order Contracting (JOC): Project begins with an Invitation for Bid (IFB) for a Master Agreement (MA). Once the MA is awarded to the lowest bidder, individual work orders are issued as needed. After a work order is executed and notice to proceed is given, construction begins.

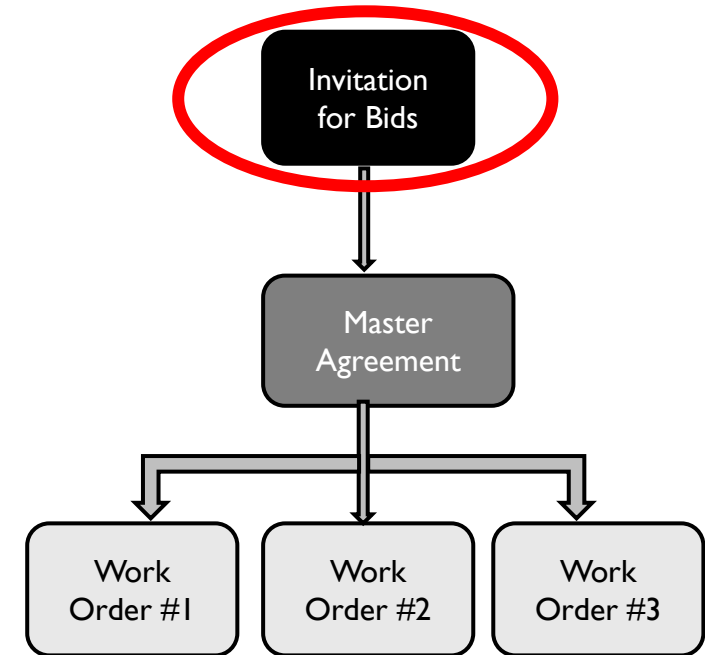

Invitation for Bid (IFB)

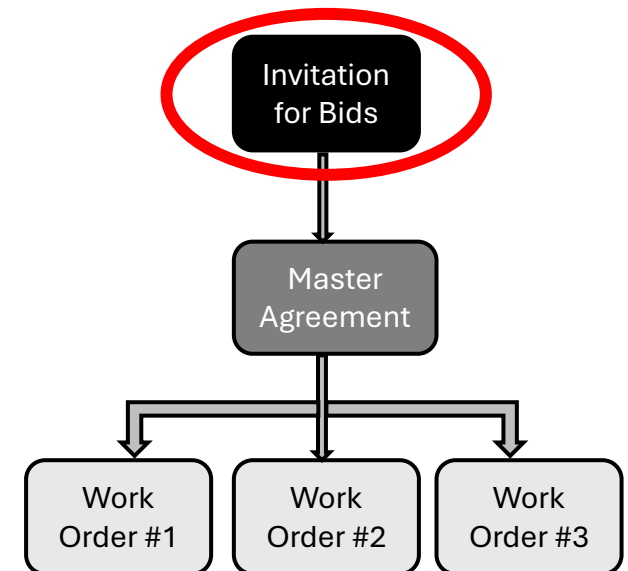
- IFB is an invitation to contractors to submit competitive bids.
- Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting.
- Defined geographical location, Plans & Notice to Bidders & Special Provisions.
- Fixed Unit Price List with anticipated quantities.
- Contractor bids on Adjustment Factors (Stipulated Unit Price)



Invitation for Bid (IFB) cont.

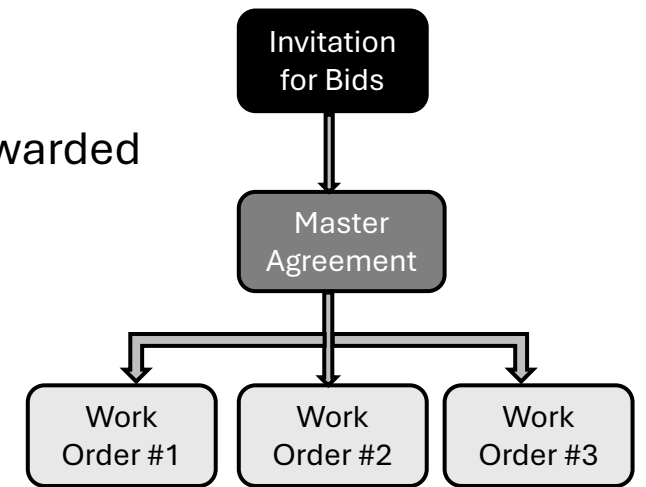
An Invitation for Bids (IFB) is a solicitation to contractors inviting them to submit competitive bids for construction services. IFB package includes:

- IFB document
- JOC Master Agreement Template
- Electronic Bidding Book (.ebsx file)
- ~ 60% Project Plans (Construction Details)
- ~ 100% Notice to Bidders & Special Provisions



Innovative Bidding Process – Job Order Contracting

- Districts will prepare the **Invitation for Bid (IFB) package**, which will include plans (although they do not need to be 100% complete), specifications (100%), and the maximum project estimates. The inhouse unit price estimates for individual work items, such as earthwork, will be disclosed. Caltrans will provide a unit price book (e.g., \$230 per cubic yard of earthwork), which reflects the fixed unit price, including material, equipment, and labor costs.
- The IFB package will be advertised through the Division of Engineering Services' Office Engineer and posted on the website. Only prequalified contractors (Refer to the IFB package) will be eligible to submit bids based on their estimated prices. For example, \$253 per cubic yard of earthwork is the stipulated unit price, which is estimated by multiplying the fixed unit price (\$230) by adjustment factor(1.1). This stipulated unit price should account for the contractor's profit, insurance, and other associated expenses.
- The project will be awarded to the contractor with the lowest bid. Caltrans and the awarded contractor will enter into a **Master Agreement (MA) contract**.
- As needed, Under the MA contract, Caltrans will issue multiple **Work Orders (WOs)** to complete specific tasks or phases of the project. Construction done.



IFB and Addenda and Project Description

Section 1.3

- Access Point: All IFB documents and addenda are posted on Cal eProcure. (<http://caleprocure.ca.gov/>)
- Proposer Responsibility:
 - Ensure software compatibility to download/view documents.
 - Register to receive updates—but must still check site frequently for changes.
 - Must acknowledge review of all posted materials in Form A (AASHTOWare Project Bids)
- Project Opportunity
 - Location and postmile limits
 - Scope
 - Funding Program
 - Total JOC Value: Not to exceed Maximum Amount

Mandatory Virtual Prebid Meeting

- Purpose: To explain the JOC process and facilitate connections between Small Businesses, DVBES, and potential Proposers.
- Format: Held via Cisco Webex on the date/time listed in Section 2. Electronic sign-in required.
- Attendance Requirement: Each Proposer must attend; representative must be a company officer, superintendent, or estimator. Joint ventures must send a representative from one of the parties.
- Proposals **will not be accepted** from non-attendees.
- Additional Notes:
 - Proposer must sign in separately for each JOC they intend to bid on.
 - Successful Proposers must report all Small Businesses hired due to this meeting.

Work Order Pricing & Term Extensions

- **Year 1:** Work Orders awarded within the original 12-month term will use stipulated unit prices from Form C (AASHTOWare Project Bids software - Year 1).
- **Year 2 Extension:** Upon executing a time extension amendment, Year 2 stipulated unit prices (Form C) will reflect a 4% price escalation, effective on the anniversary of the original agreement.
- **Year 3 Extension:** If extended again, Year 3 stipulated unit prices will increase by an additional 4% based on year 2 rates, effective on the anniversary of the first extension.

Designated Contact

- **Primary Point of Contact:**

The Department's Designated Contact is the only person authorized to receive communication regarding the IFB during the procurement phase.

- **Prohibition:**

Proposers must not contact any other Department employee about the Project or IFB.

Small Business Preference

- **Applicable to: Non-federal-aid contracts only.**
- **Eligibility:**

Small Business(SB) certified by the Department of General Services (DGS) may qualify for a preference if:

 - A completed form G found in the AASHTOWare Project Bids software, is submitted with the Price Proposal,
 - The low bidder is not SB-certified or did not request the preference.
- **Certification Requirements:**
 - Form G must be signed and submitted by the bid due date.
 - SB certification or complete DGS application must be received by 5:00 pm on the price proposal opening date.
- **Preference Amount (For bid comparison only):**
 - Lesser of 5% of the lowest non-SB bid, or \$50,000.
- **Important Notes:**
 - Preference affects bid comparison only, not contract award amount.
 - If SB is the low bidder after applying preference, NSB preference is not considered.
 - Award is based on total bid amount, not the reduced amount.

Insurance and Bonds

- **Bonds Requirement**

Required at Work Order Execution:

- Payment bond (100% of work order total),
- Performance Bond(50% of work order total).

Proposer Certification

- Must certify compliance in Form A (Transmittal letter)
- Confirms ability to obtain required bonds for each work order.

- **Insurance requirement**

Required Insurance

- Must meet standard in Standard Specification Section 7-1.06 “ Insurance.”
- Evidence of insurance required at the time of each Work Order execution.

Proposed Certification

- Certify commitment in Form A to comply with insurance requirements and provide proof as required.

Procurement Schedule

- **Procurement Schedule**

Schedule is subject to change via Addenda. Here is an example.

APPENDIX B: PRICE PROPOSAL EXAMPLE

Refer to Section 1.4.4 for additional information.

1. **Fixed Unit Price List:** Do not change.
2. **Adjustment Factor:** In the "Adjustment Factor" column, enter the Adjustment Factor for each item.

Proposers will provide an Adjustment Factor to each of the bid items. The Adjustment Factors shall be specified to three decimal places as illustrated in the following example:

$$\begin{array}{r} \underline{1.123} \\ \text{OR} \\ \underline{0.987} \end{array}$$

Note: The example Adjustment Factors shown above are for example purposes only and are not an indication of factors being bid by the Proposer.

3. **Stipulated Unit Price:** In the "Stipulated Unit Price, enter the calculation of Fixed Unit Price multiplied by the Proposer's bid of the Adjustment Factor.
 $\text{Fixed Unit Price} \times \text{Adjustment Factor} = \text{Stipulated Unit Price}$
4. **Item Total Amount:** In the Item Total Amount column, enter the Item Total Amount for that item.
 $\text{Quantity Estimate} \times \text{Stipulated Unit Price} = \text{Item Total Amount}$
5. **Total:** In the Total, sum all of the Item Total Amount. This is the total amount of the Price Proposal. The total amount of the Price Proposal determines the Low Bid.
 $\text{Sum of Item Total Amount} = \text{Total}$

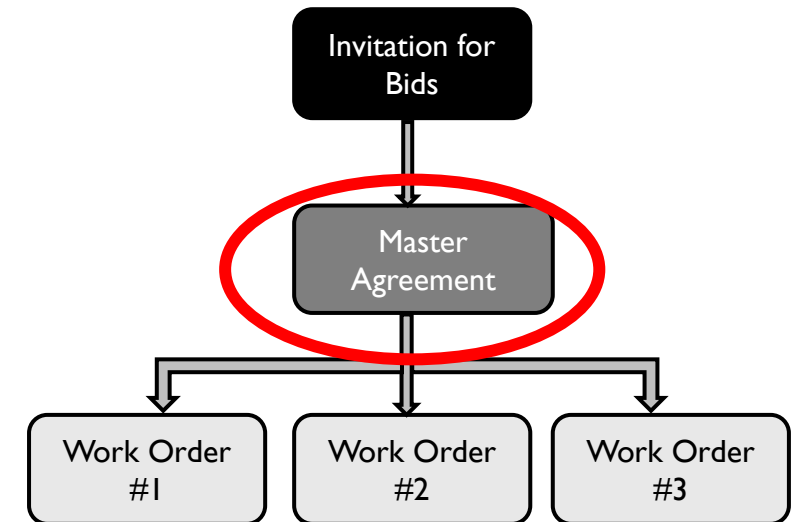

Master Agreement (MA)

- Caltrans (DES-OE) will award the JOC MA to the lowest responsive & responsible bidder.
- MA is a contract between the Department and Contractor.
- Initial 12-month contract.
- Can amend for time extension, two 12-month periods (up to 36 months).
- Can amend for additional work items, plans, and specifications.
- Can amend to increase maximum total amount payable by the Department.



Master Agreement (Cont.)

- MA can be awarded to single or multiple contractors (not to exceed 3).
- For multiple award, Work Order(s) will first be assigned to the first ranked Contractor.
- If the first bid ranked Contractor is unable to perform the Work specified in the Work Order, the second ranked Contractor will be offered the Work Order.
- If the second bid ranked Contractor is unable to perform the Work specified in the Work Order, the Work Order will be offered to the third bid ranked Contractor.

Master Agreement Maximum Amount, and Project Description

- The total amount payable by the Department under the JOC MA will be mentioned in section 1.1.2.
- Bid rankings are based on the lowest responsive, responsible, and prequalified Proposers.
- Contractors are ranked based on the lowest price proposal.
- The lowest invitation for Bid Price Proposal ranks 1st, and so on.
- Contractors must perform at least 30% of each Work Order using their own employees and equipment.
- Contractors must hold either a Class A license or specific Class C license or it will be described in IFB and NTB&SP.

Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise (DVBE) & Small Business

- Contractors must ensure maximum opportunity for DVBE, & Small Business participation.
- No discrimination based on race, color, national origin , or sex.
- Non-compliance is a material breach and may lead to contract termination or to other remedies.
- Submit participation forms with each billing.
- DVBE Goals per Work Order Value
 - < \$1 million: DVBE goal=5%, \$1M - \$5M: DVBE goal=5%, > \$5M: No DVBE goal.

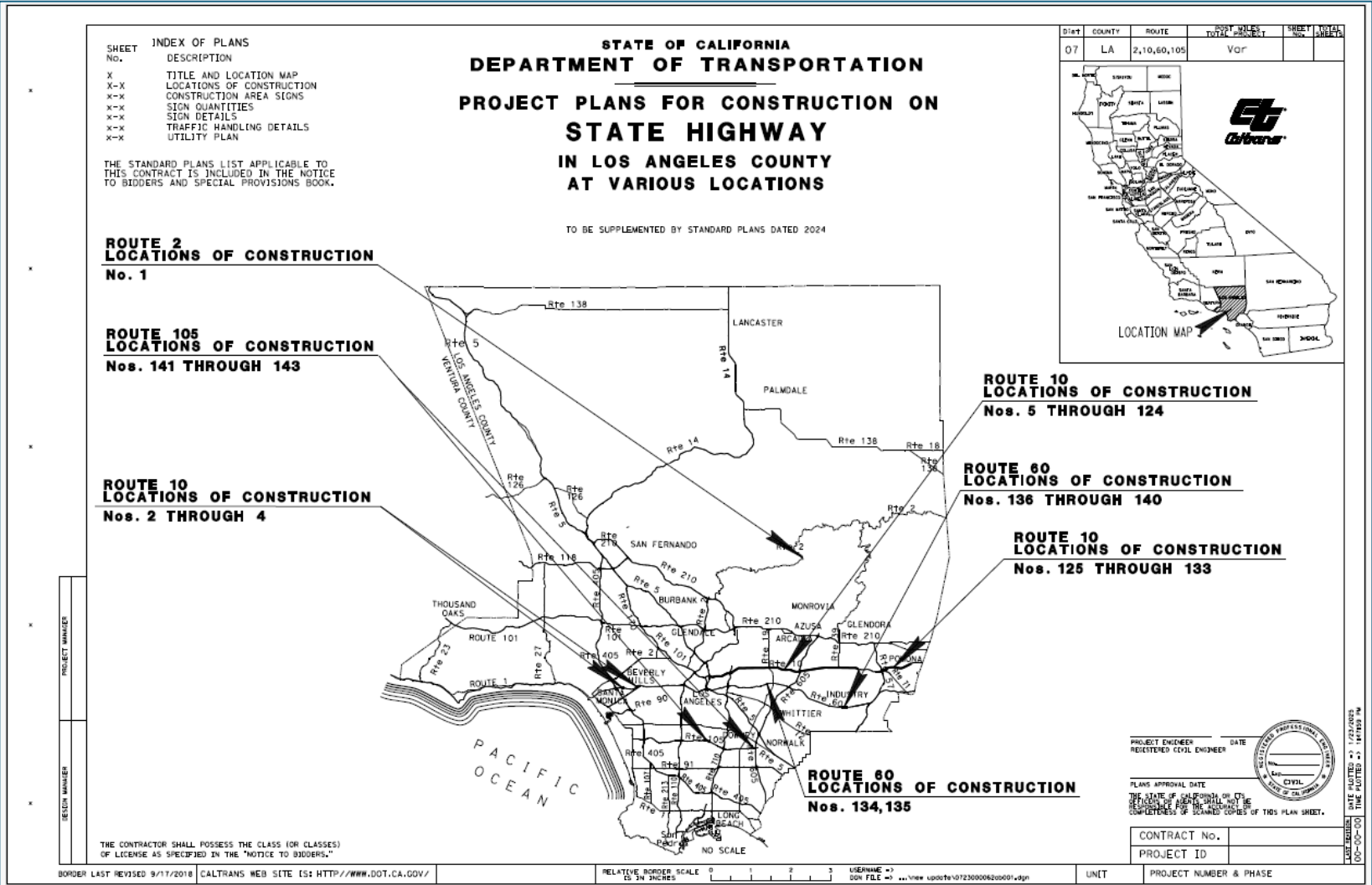

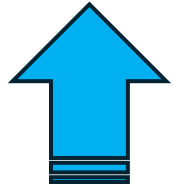

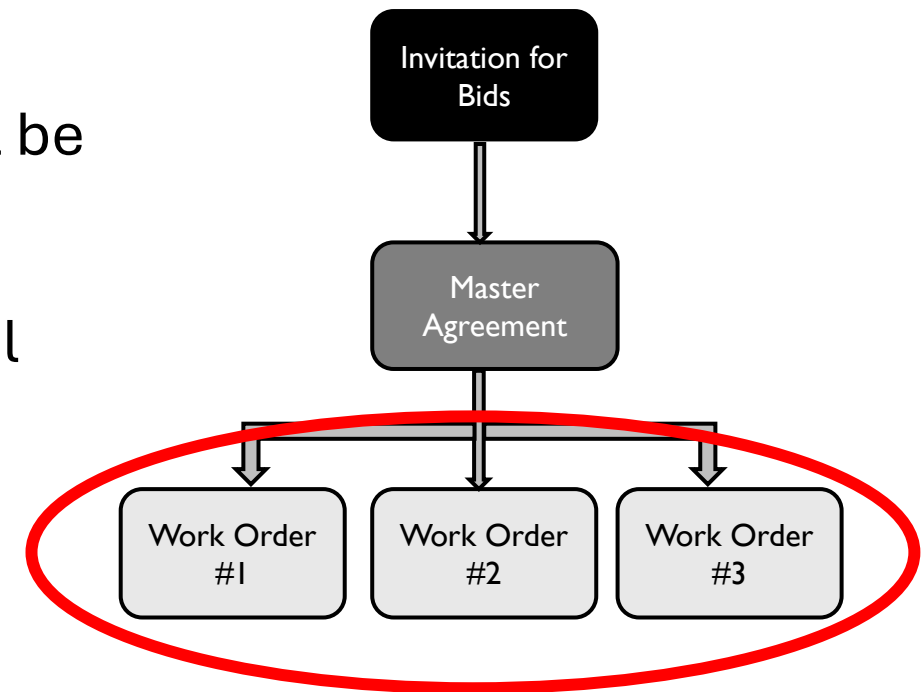

WORK ORDER (WO) OVERVIEW



Work Order(WO)

- Once MA executed, WOs can be issued as an individual construction contracts.
- Prior to issuing each WO, Joint Scope Meeting shall be arranged to discuss scope of work, bid items, quantities...etc.
- Each WO includes Bid Book (items, quantities, total price), location, Project Plans, Notice to Bidders & Special Provisions.
- Work Order activities are permitted after the JOC Master Agreement expiration.
- Work Order can be issued/executed on the last day, i.e., before MA expires.



Joint Scope Meeting

Draft Work Order Review

After District Issues Draft Work Order to Contractor:

- **Within 7 business days of receiving the revised draft Work Order** - The Contractor shall review the revised draft Work Order and request any changes or modifications thereto.
- District provides final work order after the first or second Contractor's review and modifications, if applicable.

Final Work Order

After District Issues Final Work Order:

- Within **five (5) Business Days of issuing the final Work Order** - The Contractor shall sign and return to the Contract Manager (Use Adobe Sign)

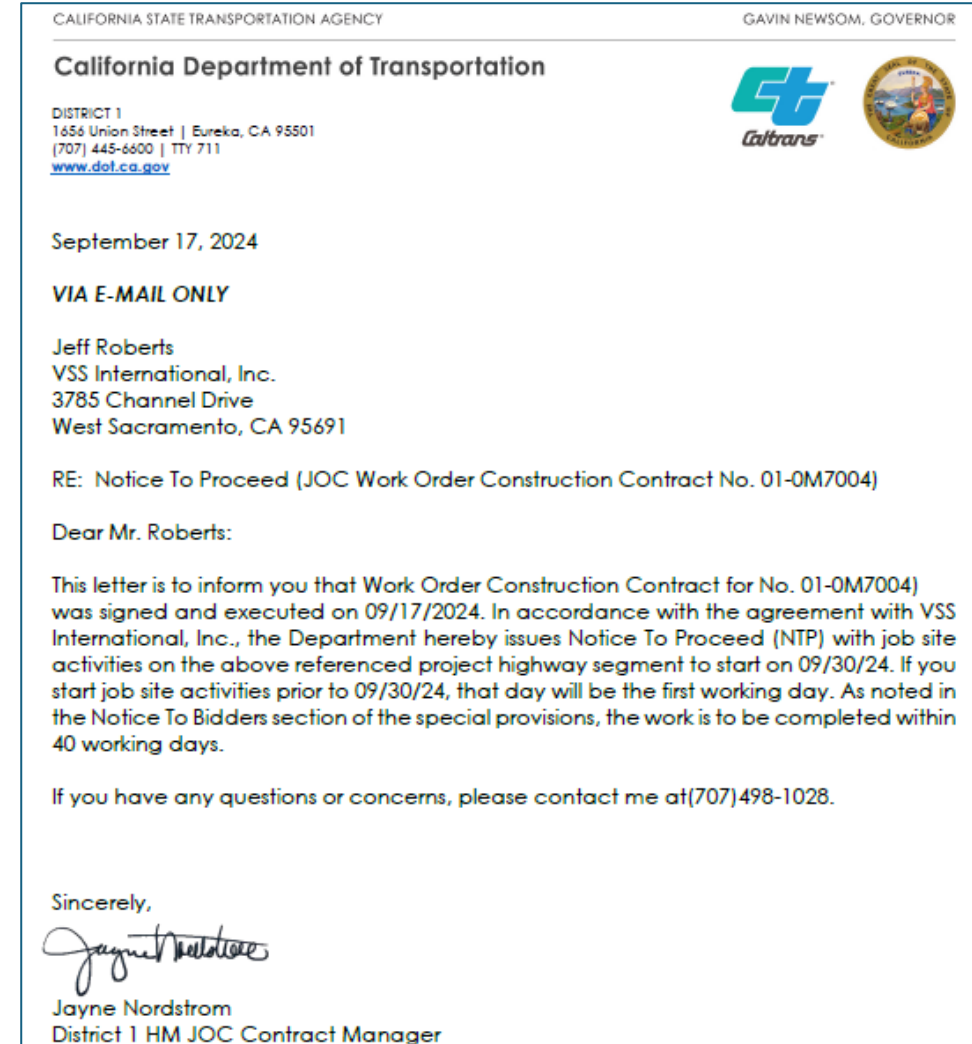

In the Invitation for Bid (IFB), contractors competitively bid based on their Adjustment Factors on each item listed in the Fixed Unit Price List; this Stipulated Unit Price will be used to price all Work Orders. The Department awards the JOC Master Agreement to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. The initial JOC Master Agreement is for 12-months with an option of extending for up to two 12-month periods. Work Orders are then issued as an individual construction contract, which identify specific location(s) and items of work.
