<p>New Business</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Introductions 2. Status of Scoping Document Development <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • General <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Focus on developing and getting scoping documents approved for this fiscal year. Typical process is that scoping documents to be approved by July of the fiscal year ii. About a month out from having scoping documents finalized and approved for iii. Scoping documents will be reviewed and signed as soon as complete vs waiting until the next EC quarterly meeting iv. Current prioritization list has been approved by the EC • Priority 1 - Pavement Smoothness <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Deborah has developed a draft, will share with STG ii. Will not combine with ATG; there will be two different scoping documents iii. Scoping document developed to evaluate and monitor iv. Bruce asks for steps for implementing as guidelines. Will be discussed in next meeting. Output from implementation meeting to be sent Bruce and others for awareness.

- v. Important that chair of working group is monitoring what UCPRC is currently doing. Needs to have continued communication with spec write
- Priority 2 – Precast Pavement: Phase II
 - i. Phase II to enhance the jobsite quality. Gather lessons learned from the past few years and review and improve specifications.
 - ii. Will create report in the end to document best practices
 - iii. Working on developing names for the working group/task teams
 - iv. Scoping document to include names for working groups in order to get approved
- Priority 3 – 4x8 Cylinders
 - i. Working on draft scoping document
 - ii. Current CT's will be revised to the ASTMs
 - iii. Working on team members for working group
- Priority 4 – Long-Life Concrete Pavements
 - i. A lot of pavements that were developed in the 60's are still in service today.
 - ii. Wants to capture what can be done to make pavements last longer
- Priority 5 – Unique Concrete Mix Design Naming System
 - i. Will re-start this effort
 - ii. Brett Soldano will be the working group lead
 - iii. Nathan will be the Industry lead
 - iv. Want to make sure what is developed works with industry
- Priority 6 – Recycled Crushed Concrete Aggregate
 - i. Was previously developed by M&QA and CIP jointly
 - ii. Dulce suggests studying the use of recycled concrete aggregate in general
 - iii. Bruce states that the use of recycled concrete should be performance based
 - iv. If started including structural, etc then the scoping document would have to go back up to EC. Will focus on CIP for now
 - v. Ron Jones working group chair, Samir Ead from construction, METS TBA, Deepak Maskey
- Priority 7 – Concrete Pavement with limited construction window
