

PMPC Executive Committee Meeting Minutes

Purpose: Share information related to the activities of the PMPC

1. Reviewed ATG Work Product scoping documents and approved.
 - a. EC members reviewed scoping documents focusing on the status and schedules of the milestones.
 - b. Scoping Documents
 - i. Statistical Pay Factors
 1. EC reviewed and approved scoping document.
 2. EC recommended to add note that Construction A&E resources is anticipated.
 - ii. Pavement Smoothness Specifications
 1. Scoping document will be reviewed and signed.
 2. Development of training materials is on progress, and scheduled pavement smoothness training for the next month.
 3. Division of Construction is working on a data input page.
 4. Emails will be sent out to all Caltrans Districts for the formation of a pavement smoothness specification implementation team.
 5. Scoping document is modified to catch up to work that is already being completed.
 6. The intent of the current scoping document is to utilize the specification and garner data over an entire construction season.
 7. The required resources mentioned in the scoping document have captured only TG level efforts.
 8. The comments from Caltrans and Industry have been addressed in the specification.
 9. EC recommended to split pavement smoothness scoping document into two scoping documents:
 - a. Training and Implementation
 - b. Maintenance and Review
 10. Scoping document was still at the ATG level, and not ready for EC review.
 11. Hold on revising per EC.
 - iii. RAP Up to 40% in Hot Mix Asphalt
 1. EC agreed to approve scoping document as modified (removing struck out milestones).
 - iv. 2018 Section 94 Asphaltic Emulsions Update
 1. EC approved scoping document.

- v. California Test 125
 - 1. Scoping document was not ready for review at the ATG level but will be ready for STG review and expected to be ready for ATG review by the end of November.
- vi. Hamburg Wheel-Track Test for RHMA-G Mixes
 - 1. Scoping document was not ready for EC review but ATG committed to submit for EC review by the end of November.
- vii. FDR-PC Specification Update
 - EC decided to send back scoping document with the following recommendations:
 - 1. Focus on expanding usage and delineate impediments to use existing specification and a plan for resolution.
 - 2. Milestone chart need to be consistent with the approach.
 - 3. Limit to first two milestones with additional clarity for literature review and what the workplan will include.
- 2. Review CTG Work Product scoping documents and approve.
 - a. Time did not permit to review scoping documents.
- 3. Open Discussion
 - In general, EC members discussed and recommended:
 - a. The template of the scoping document should be improved.
 - b. The scoping document should consist specific issues and objectives for resolution. The milestones should be clear and focused to achieve objectives within the scheduled timelines.
