If yes, take the Written (Hurdle) Exam.

Mail a copy of the State Application (STD678) with transcripts, and evaluation (if applicable) to: Caltrans Exam Services P.O. Box 168036 Sacramento, CA 95816

If transcripts are from a country outside of the US, they must be evaluated by a member of the National Association of Credential Evaluation Services (NACES).
