<u>Answer</u>: Based on the Exclusion Clause for this contract, if your firm has a financial relationship with the OCTA for this improvement project then the company will be excluded from this contract.

4. When is NTP for this contract?

<u>Answer</u>: The procurement schedule is tentative. This contract will be advertised in July 2022 for 22 business days. The SOQ will be due in August 2022. The interview date is in September 2022. The DPAC goal is to have the contract executed in 75 business days from the beginning of advertisement. The goal is to follow the procurement scheduled, but sometimes there may be delays due to unforeseen factors. This answer is regarding Notice to Proceed (NTP) for contract execution.
