- 1. Will there be any materials testing requirements included in this scope?
 - a. There are no materials testing requirements in the scope of work.
- 2. Can you give us an idea of the spend of the current contract?
 - a. Current Contract 06A2971 for the amount of \$33.6 million has expended 93% within 2 years.
- 3. There is a new template for assistant roadway inspector that allows for options to replace two years of past high school education with additional work experience. Will D5 use this template?
 - a. The language has not been finalized for assistant roadway inspector. A template will be posted with the RFQ.
- 4. Is there a list of potential projects for this contract?
 - a. This is an on-call contract, and the district has a right to add or make the task orders specific. Any additional information will be included on the RFQ.
- 5. Can you give us some examples of task orders that District 5 plans to issue at the beginning of the new contract period?
 - a. Task orders will reflect all or some of the scope of work. This is an on-call contract and scope will be related to roadway construction services except materials sampling, testing, and services associated with structures.
- 6. Are you able to provide an exact date for when the RFQ documents will be available on Cal e-Procure?
