Take field samples and perform field-controlled tests of construction materials for quality assurance-with proper certifications

Identify actual and potential problems associated with the construction project work

Prepare construction contract progress and final payment quantity documents

Assist in the preparation of change orders, contract pay estimates, and other documents

Consultant personnel must be physically fit, able, and willing to work under varying conditions and shifts
